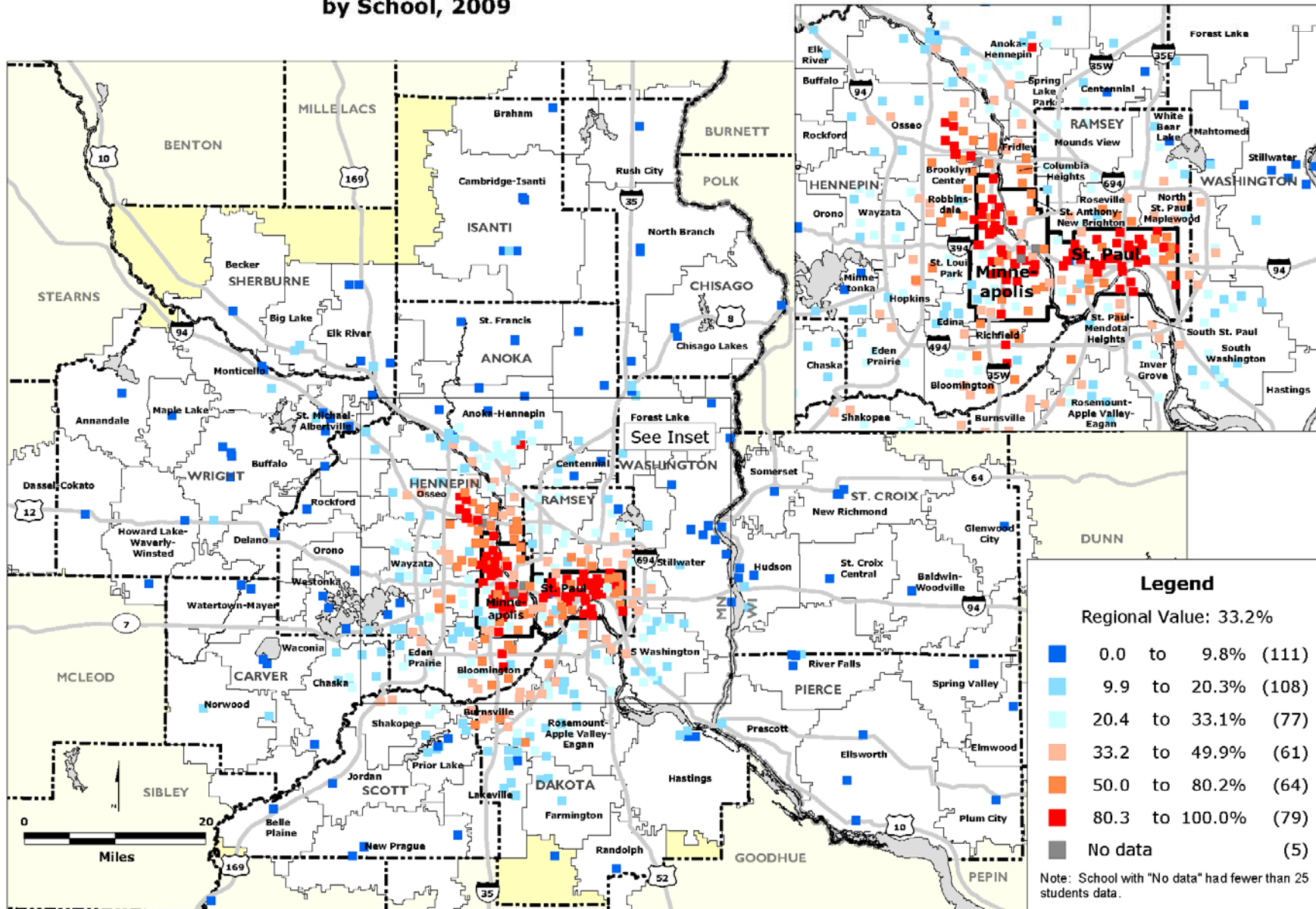

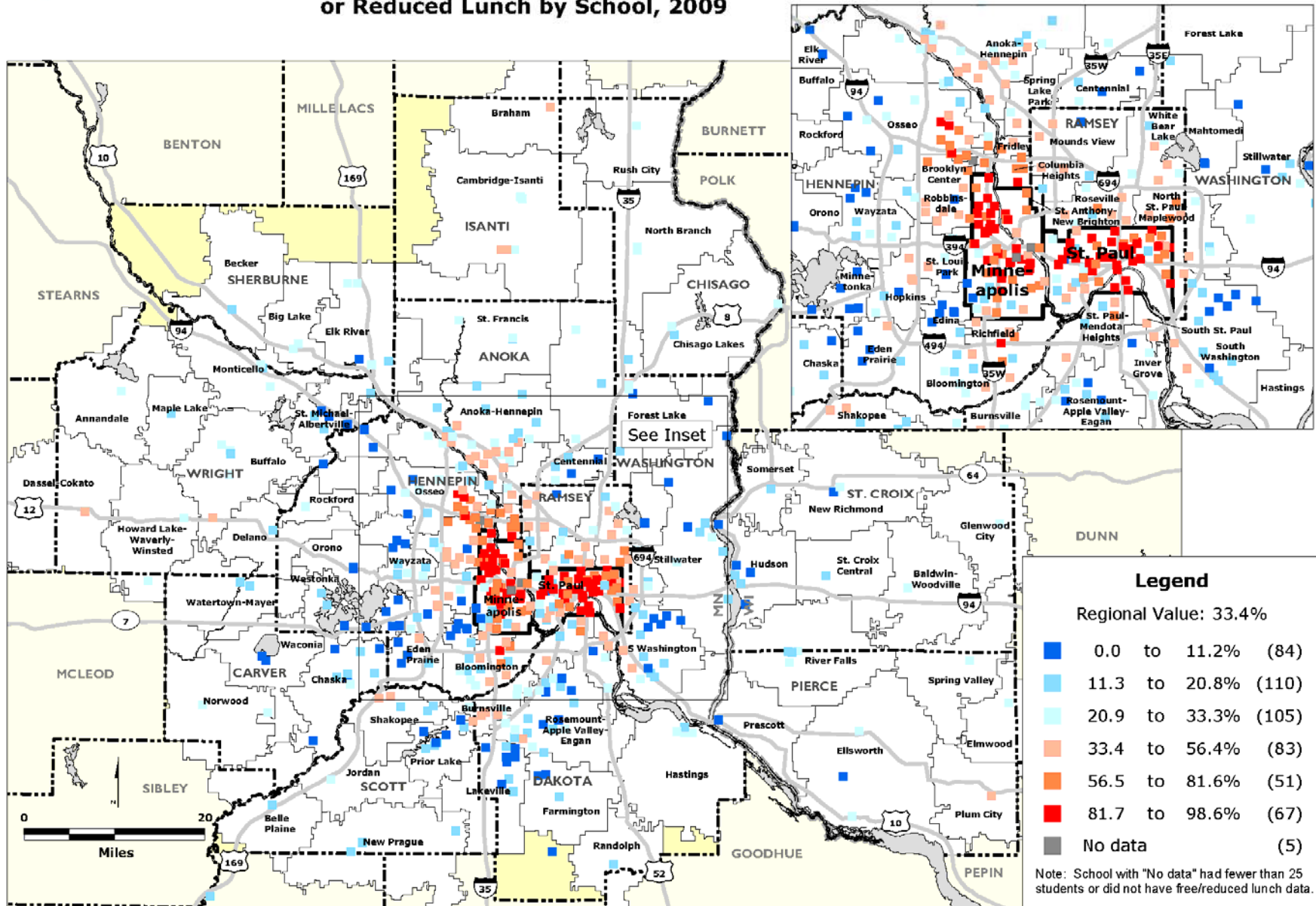

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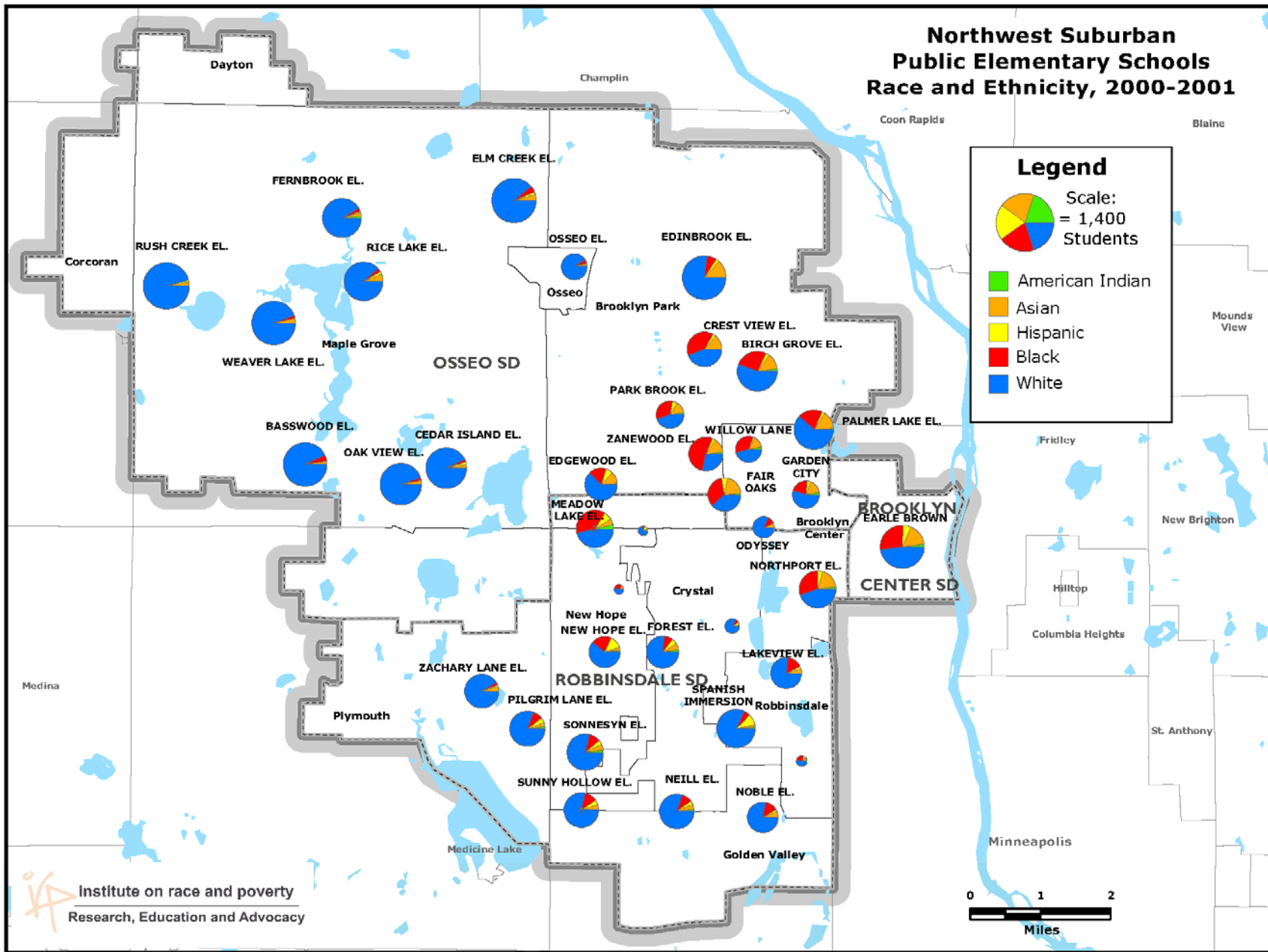
Northwest Suburban Public Elementary Schools Race and Ethnicity, 1999-2000



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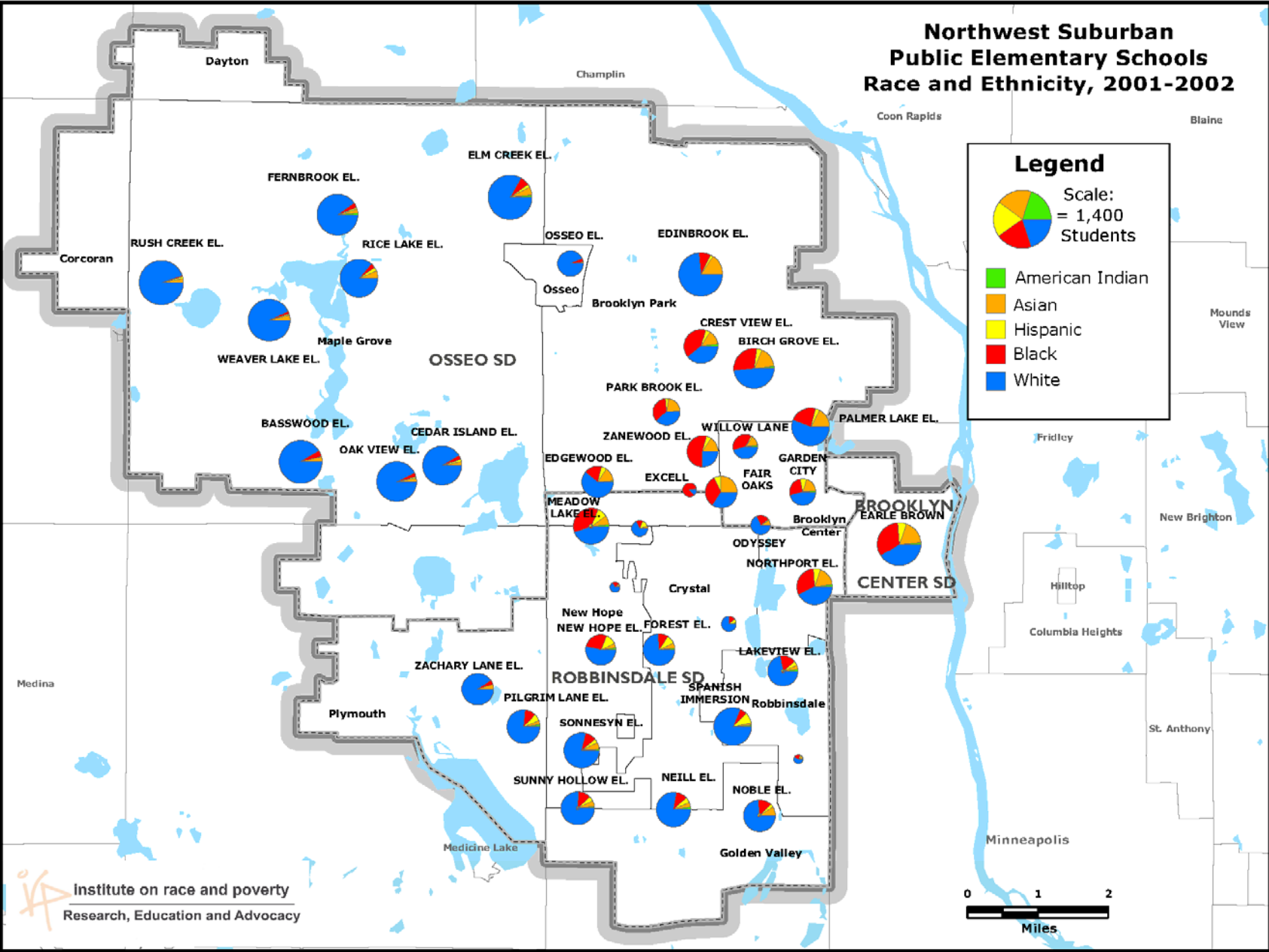

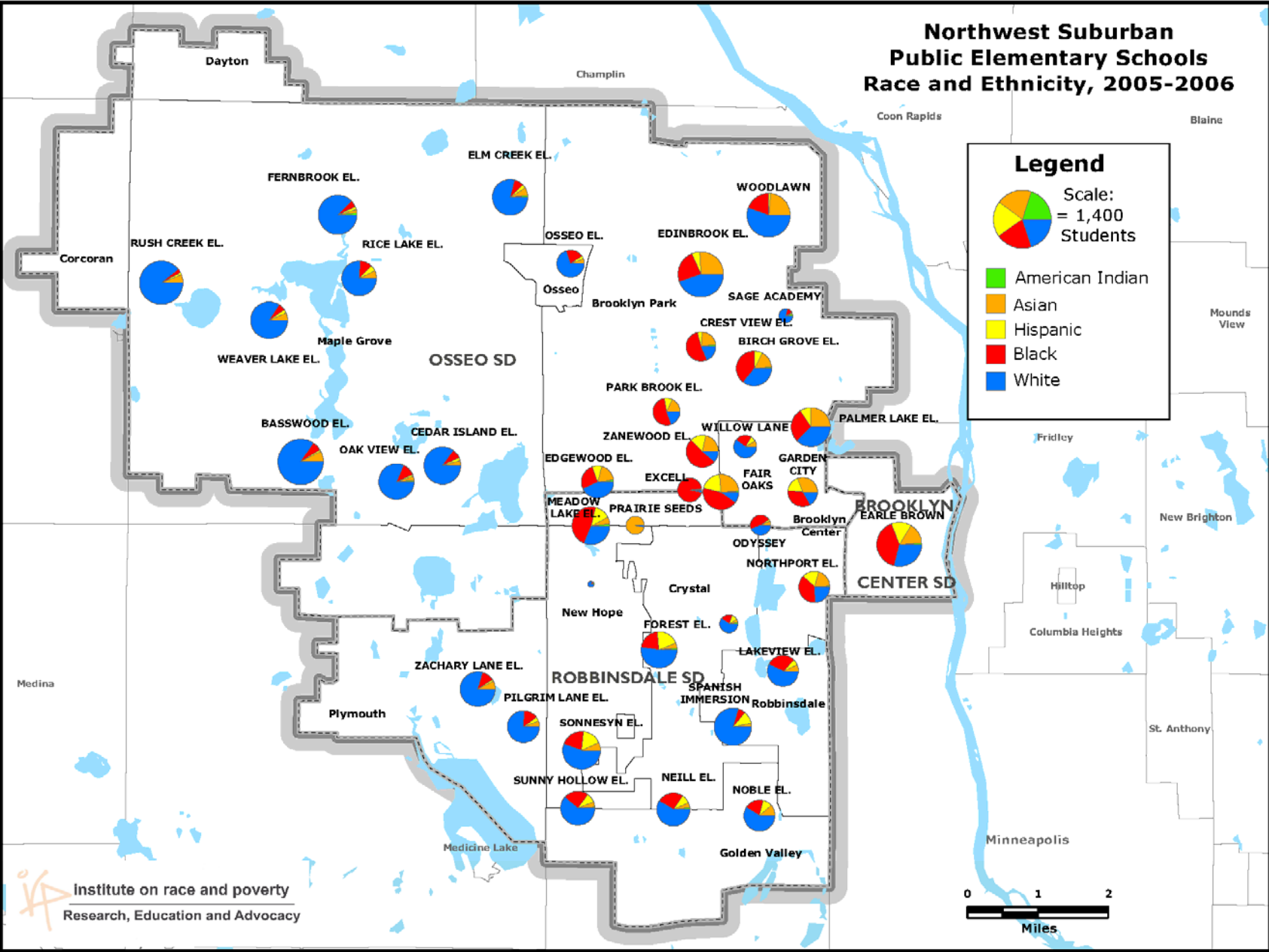
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Northwest Suburban Public Elementary Schools Race and Ethnicity, 2004-2005

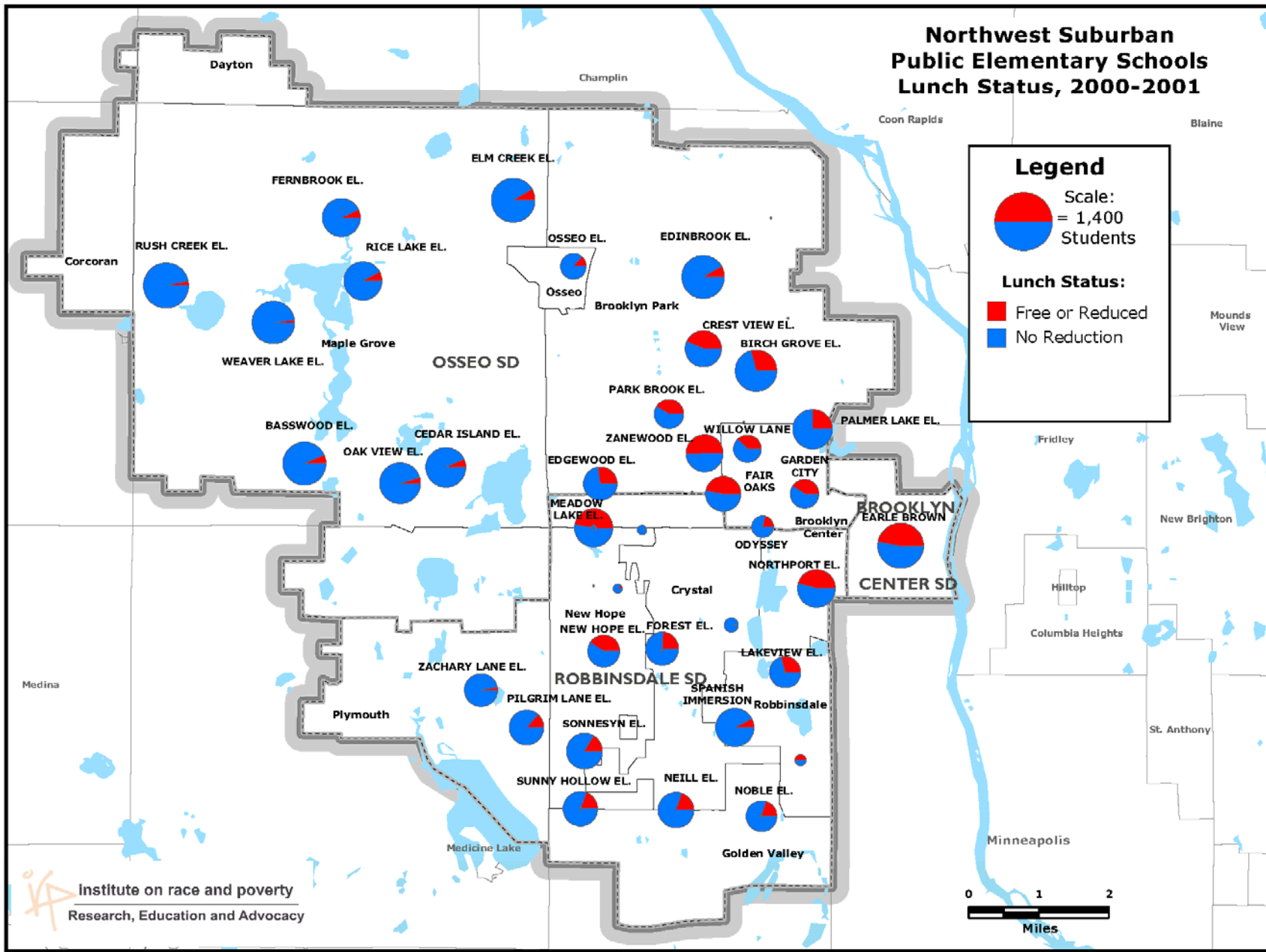
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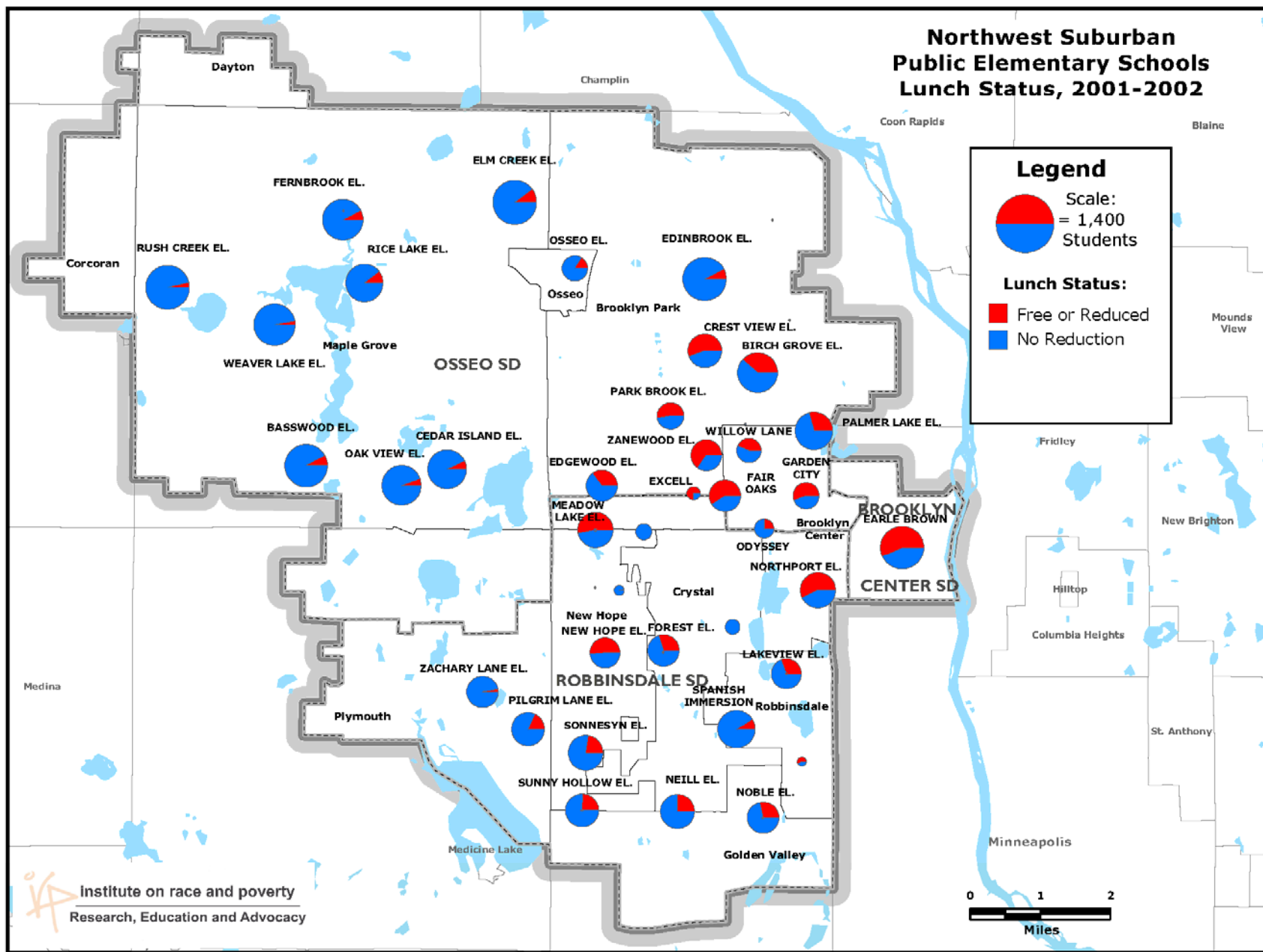
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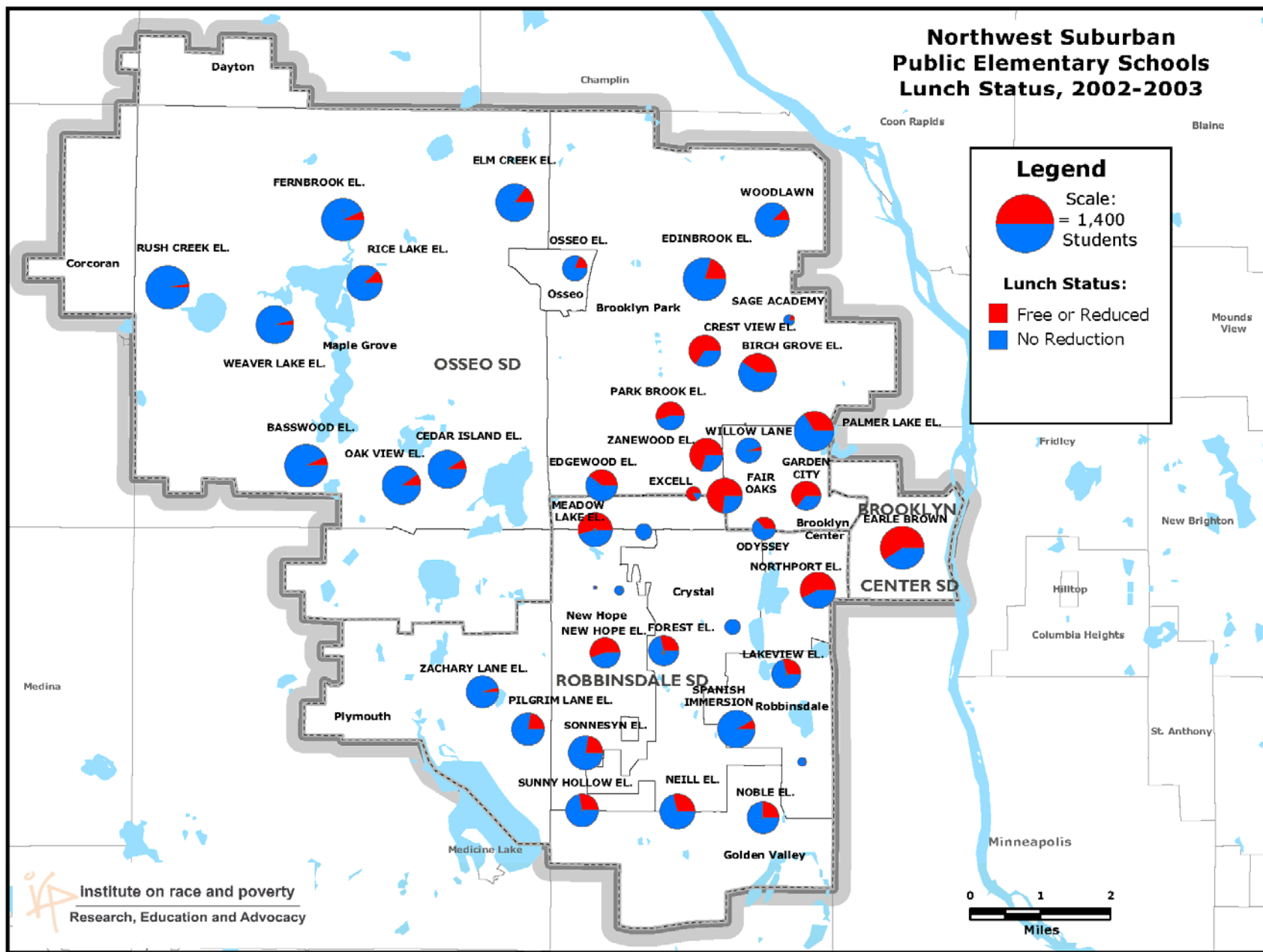
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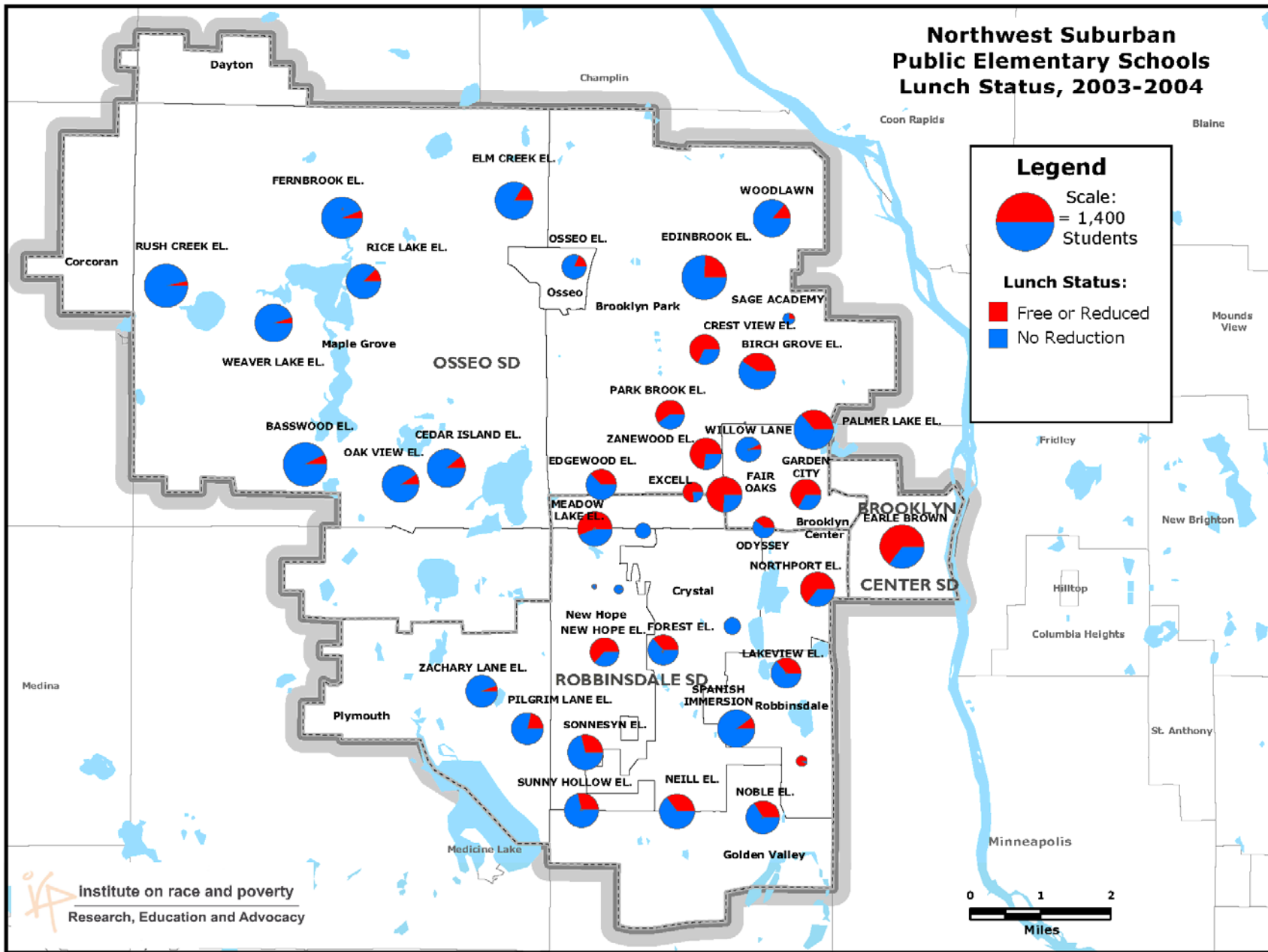
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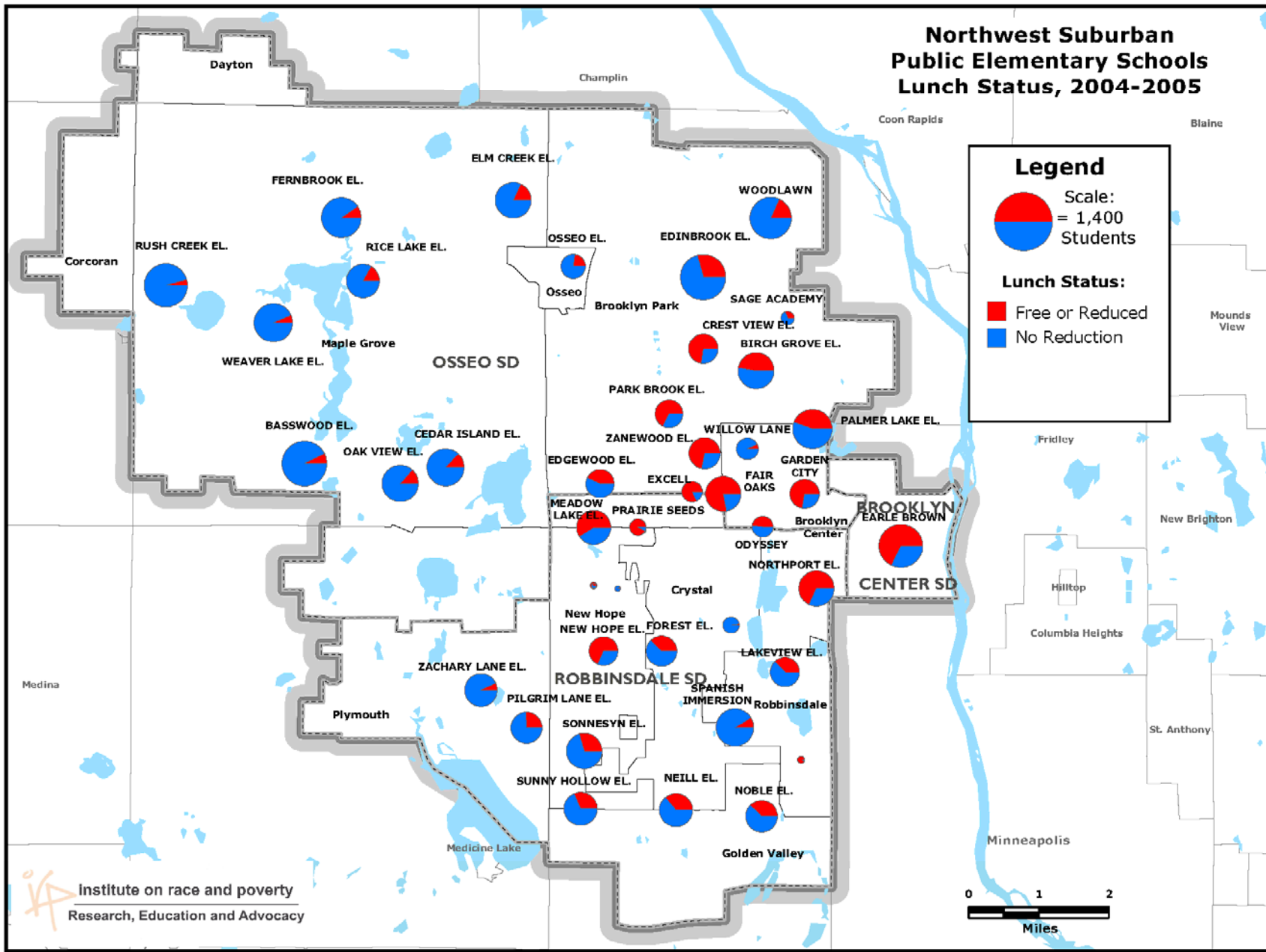
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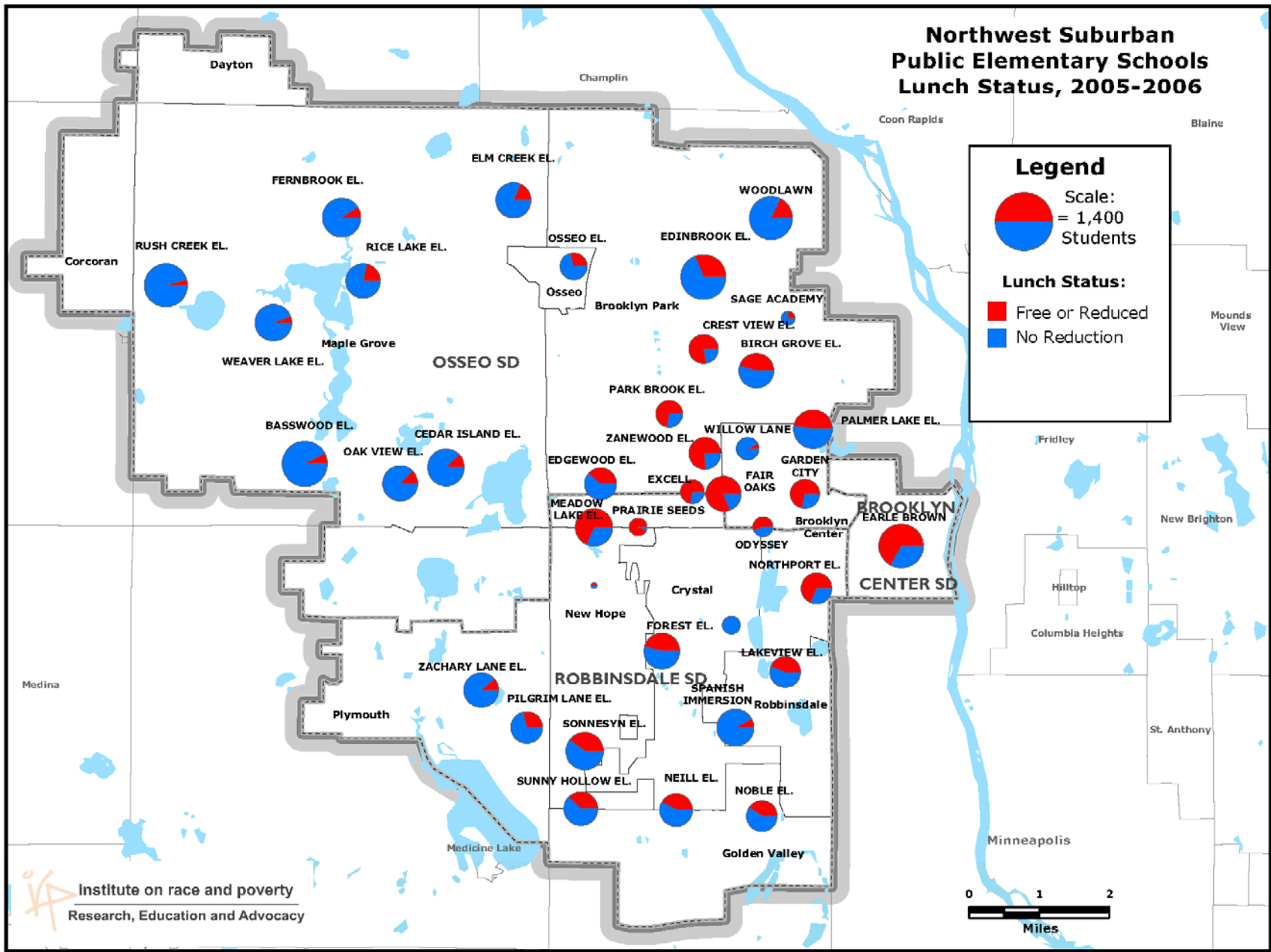
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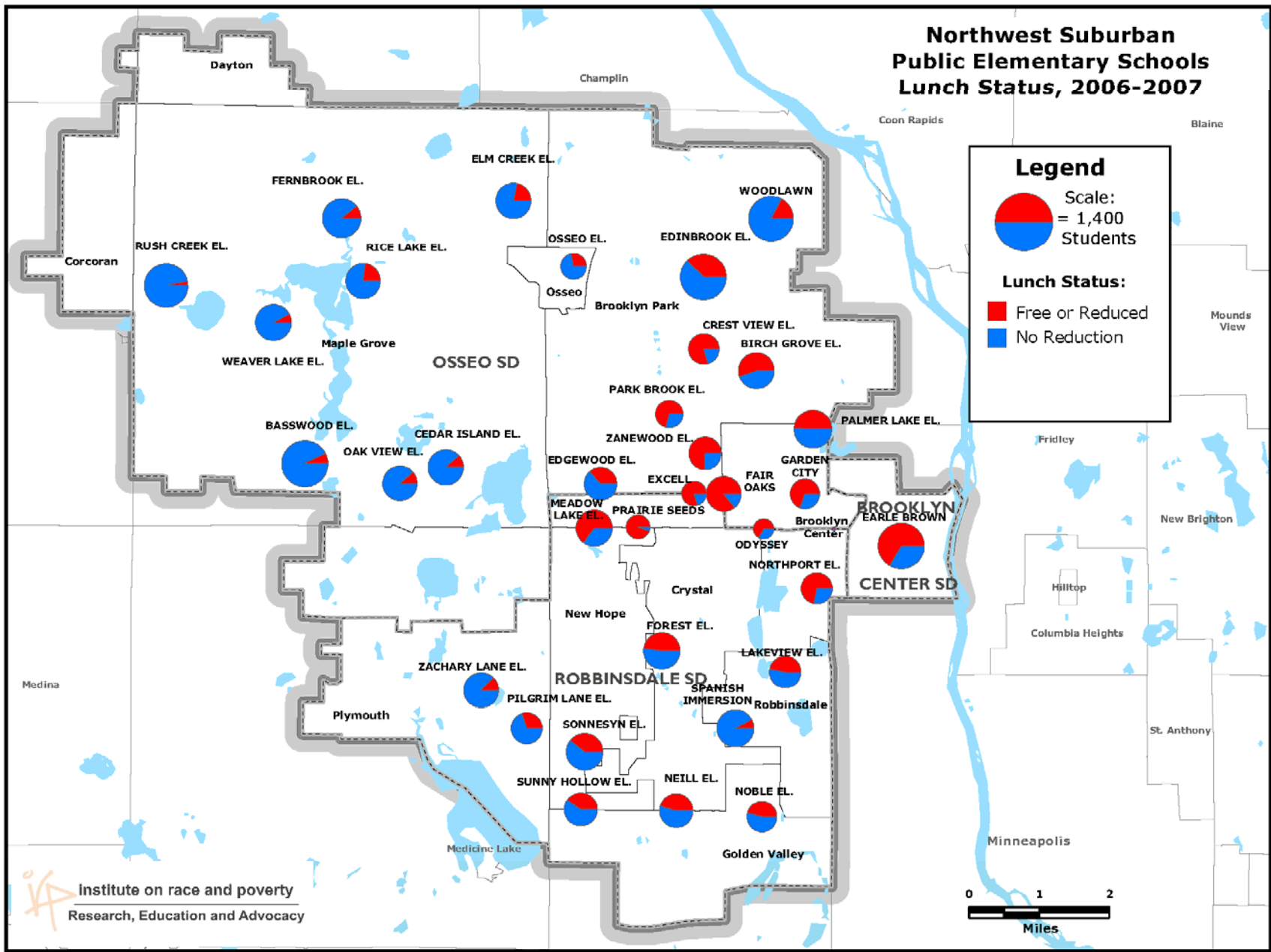
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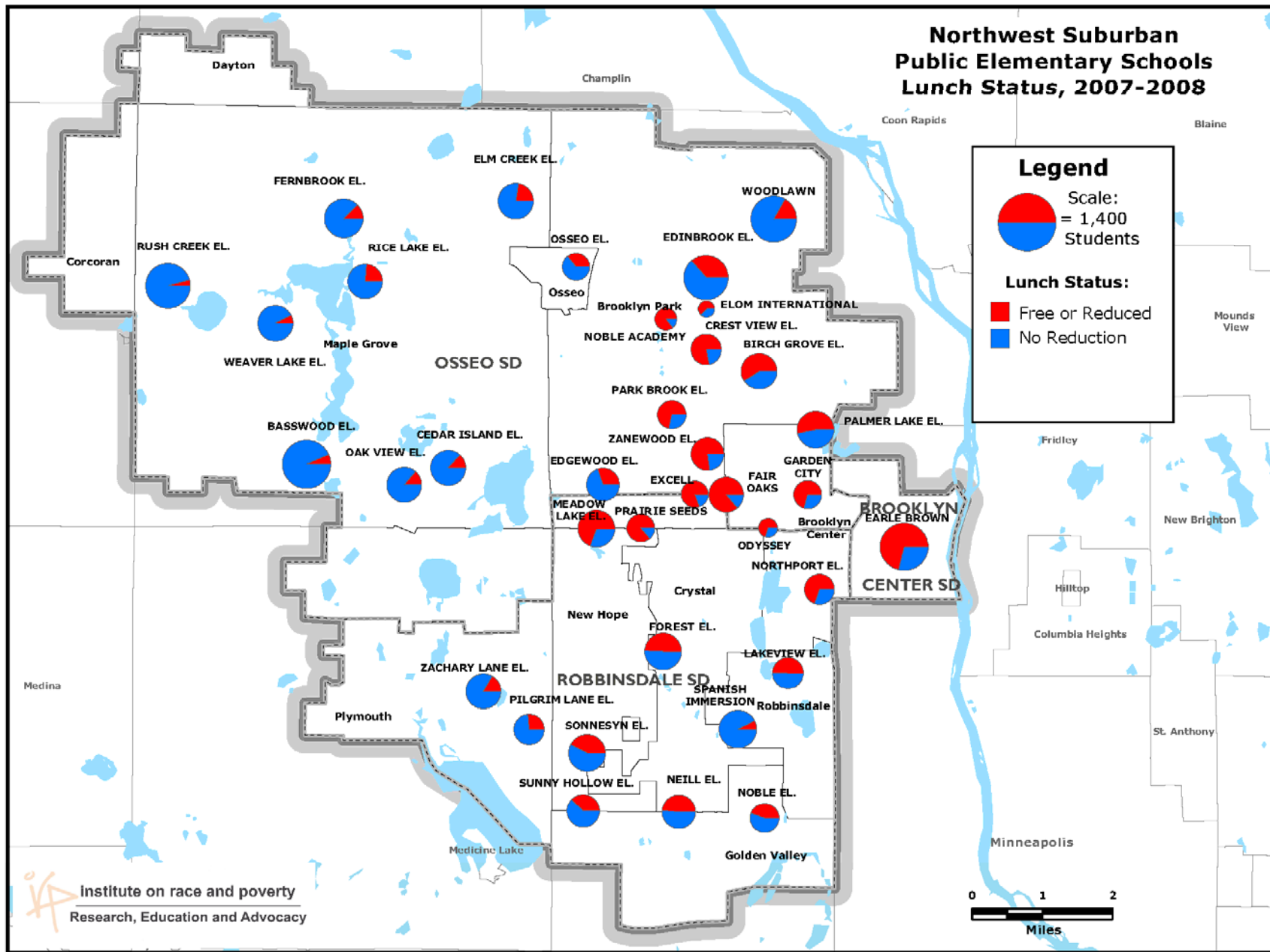


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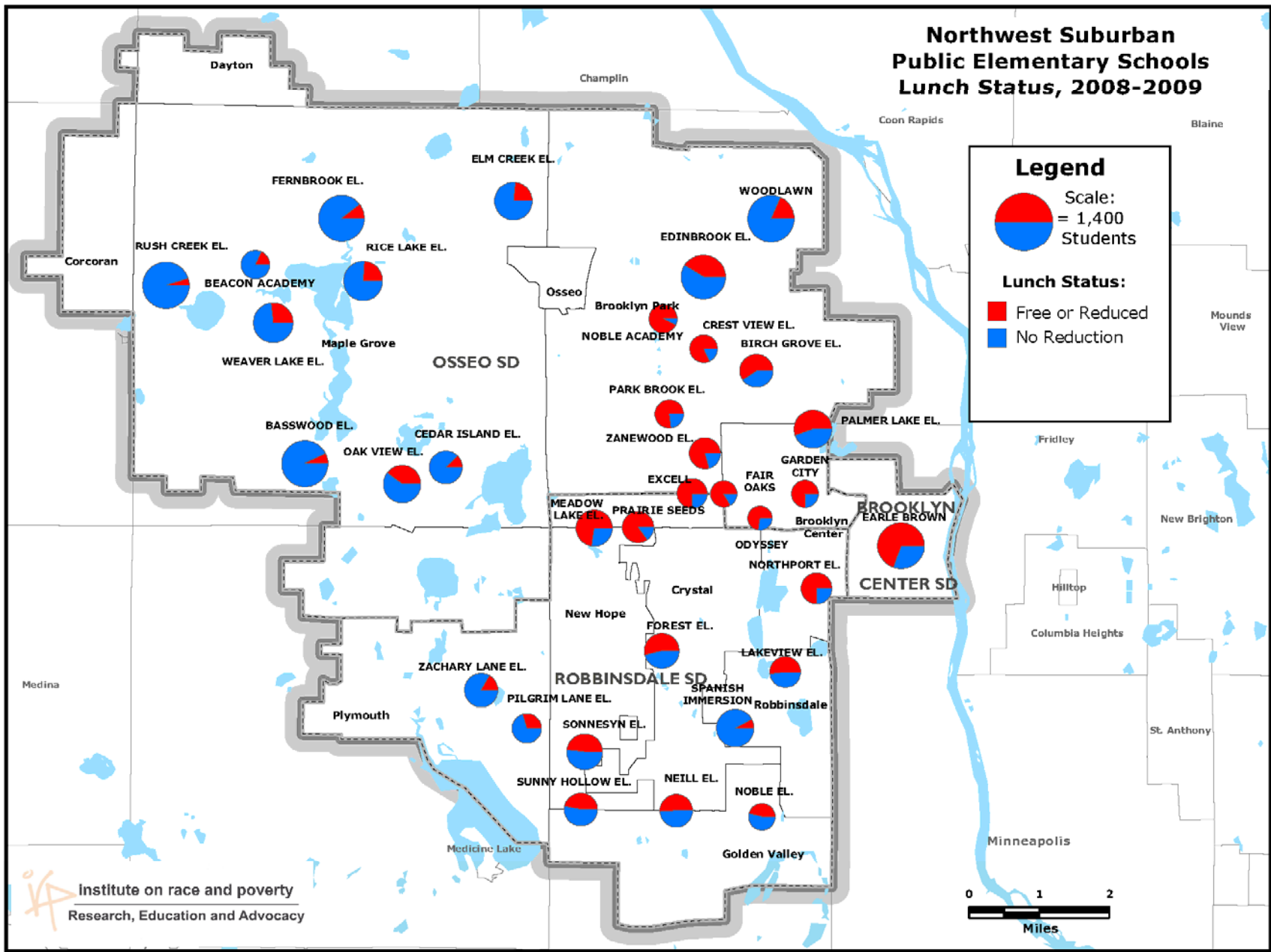


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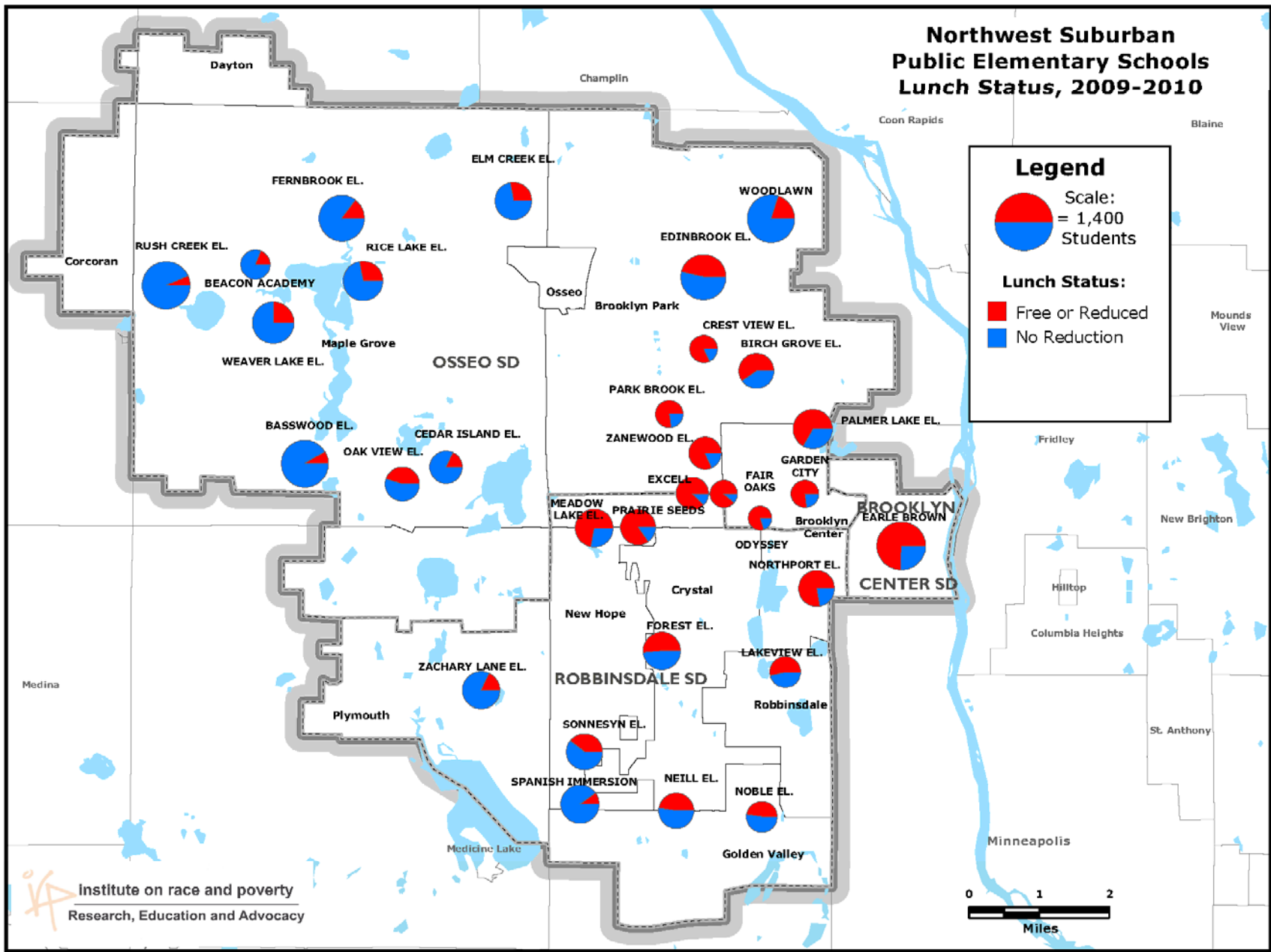
Northwest Suburban Public Elementary Schools Lunch Status, 2007-2008



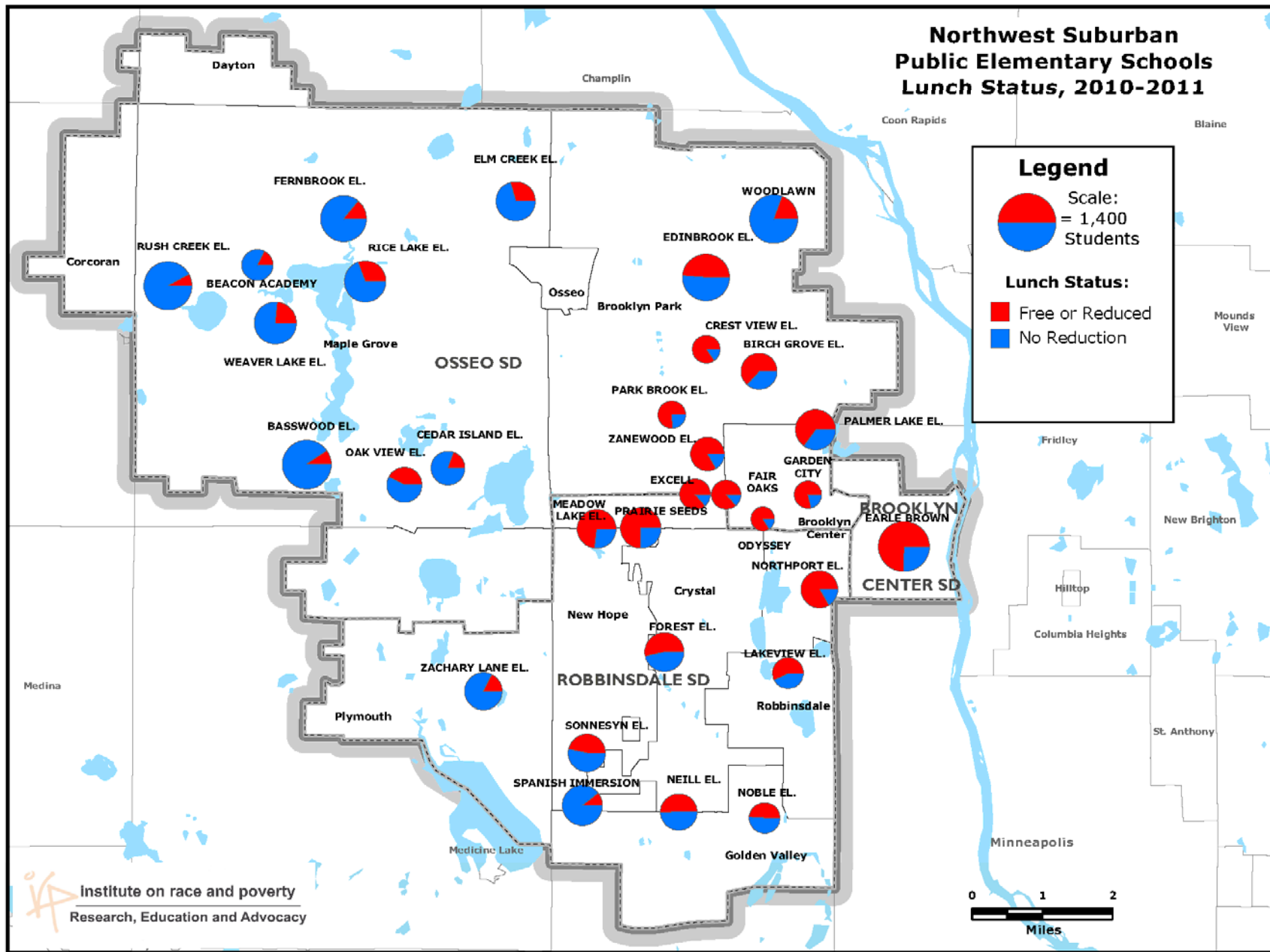

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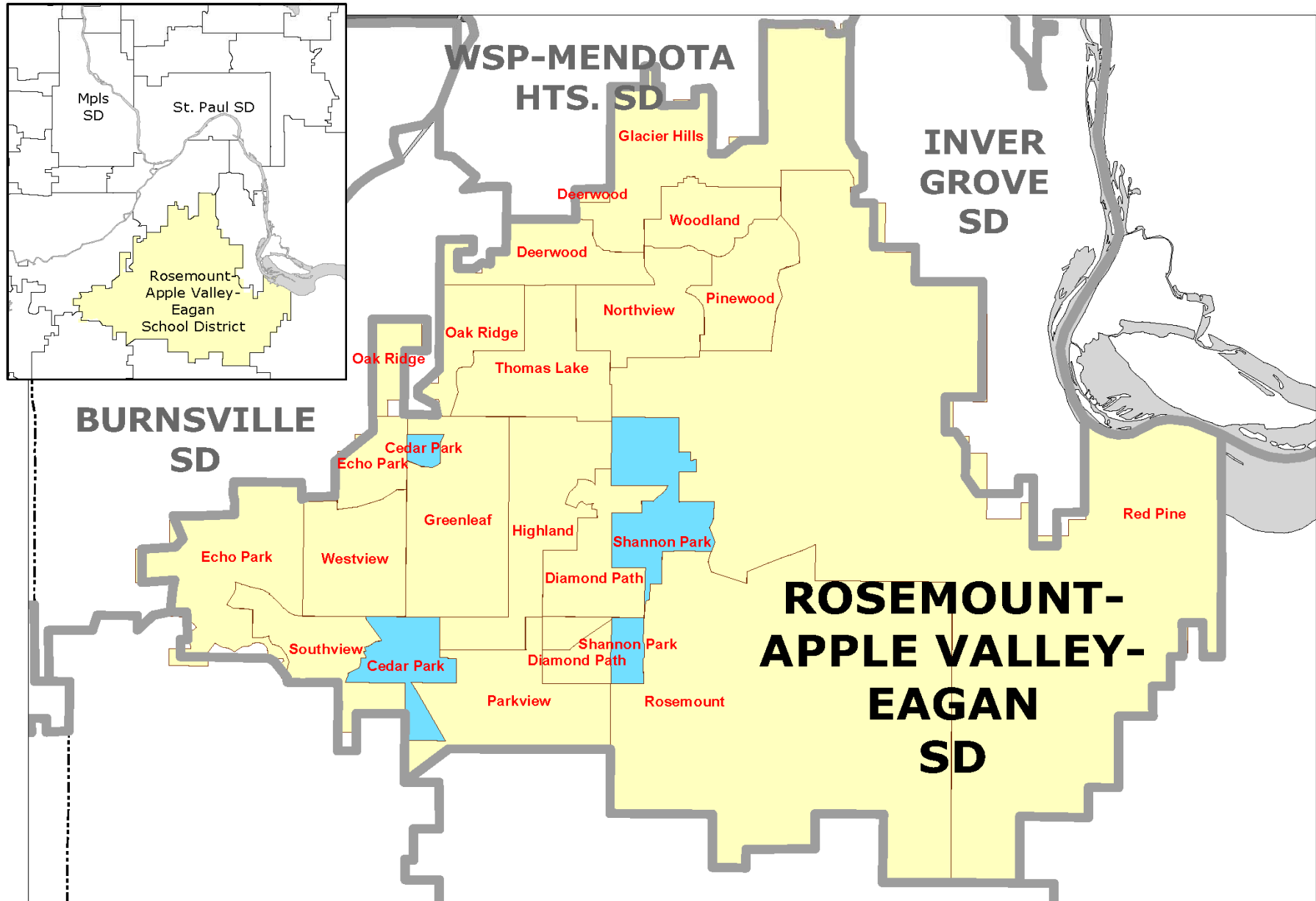

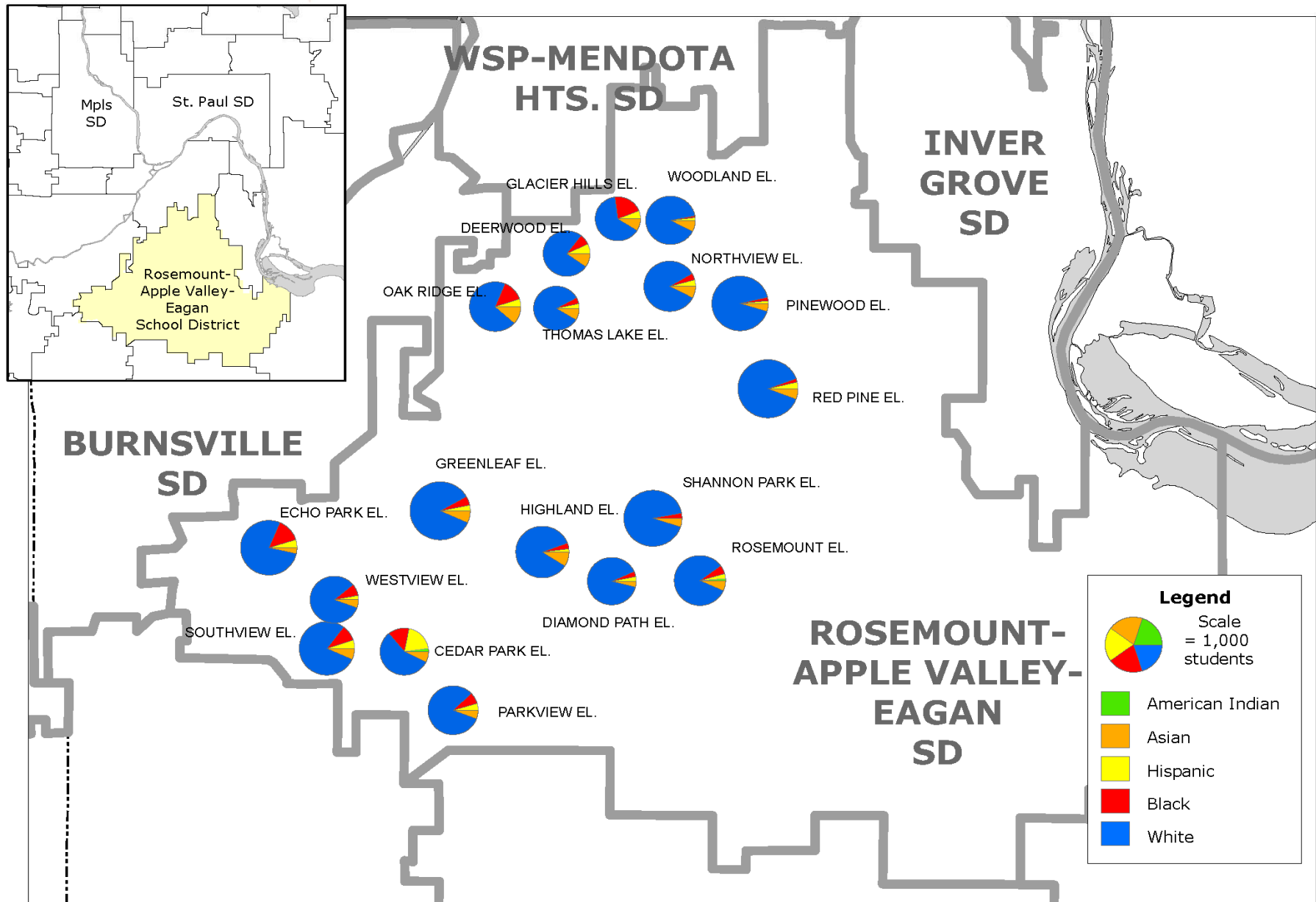

Attendance boundaries for Elementary Schools in the Rosemount-Apple Valley-Eagan School District

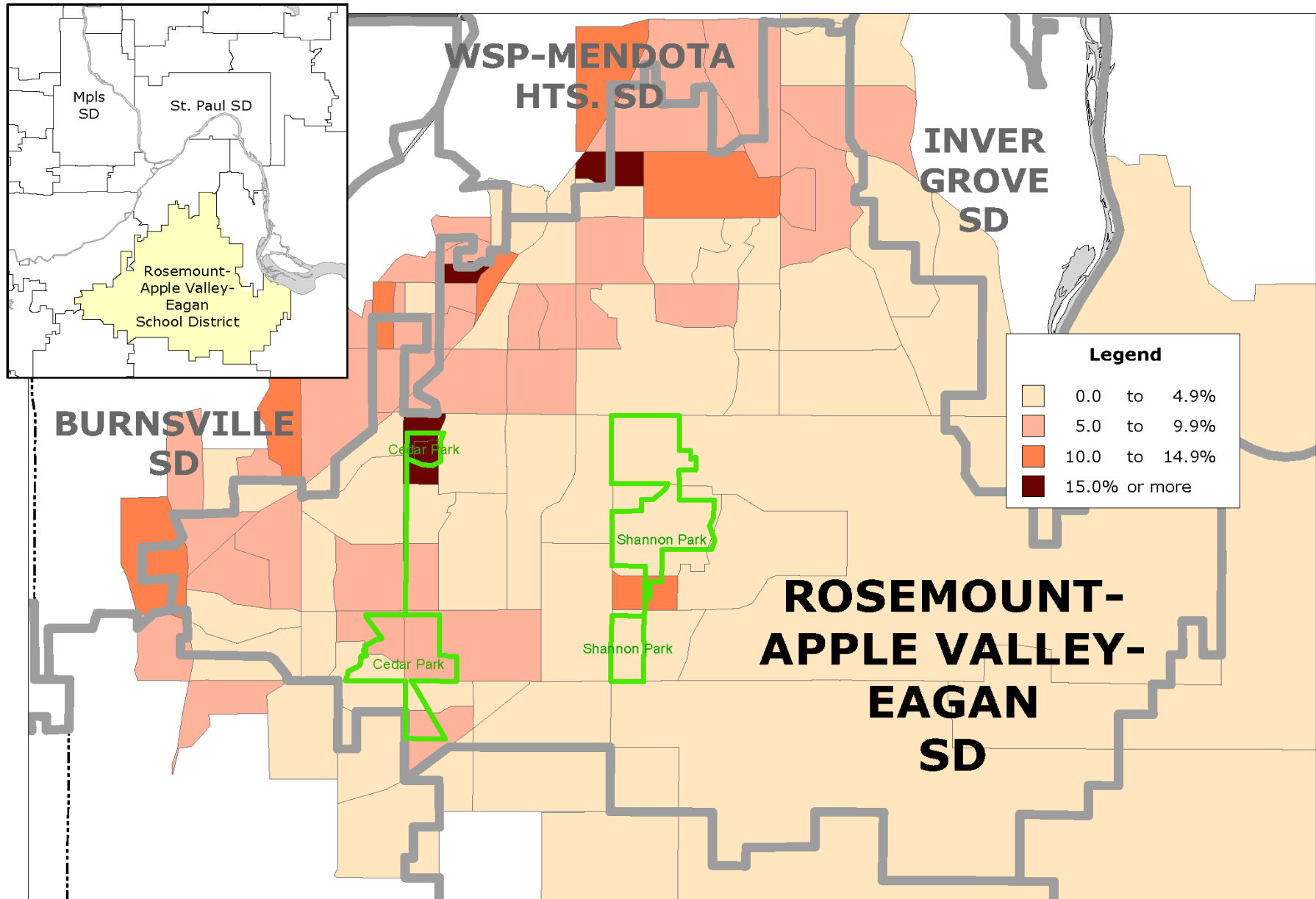


Race Data for Elementary Schools in the Rosemount-Apple Valley-Eagan School District, 2004



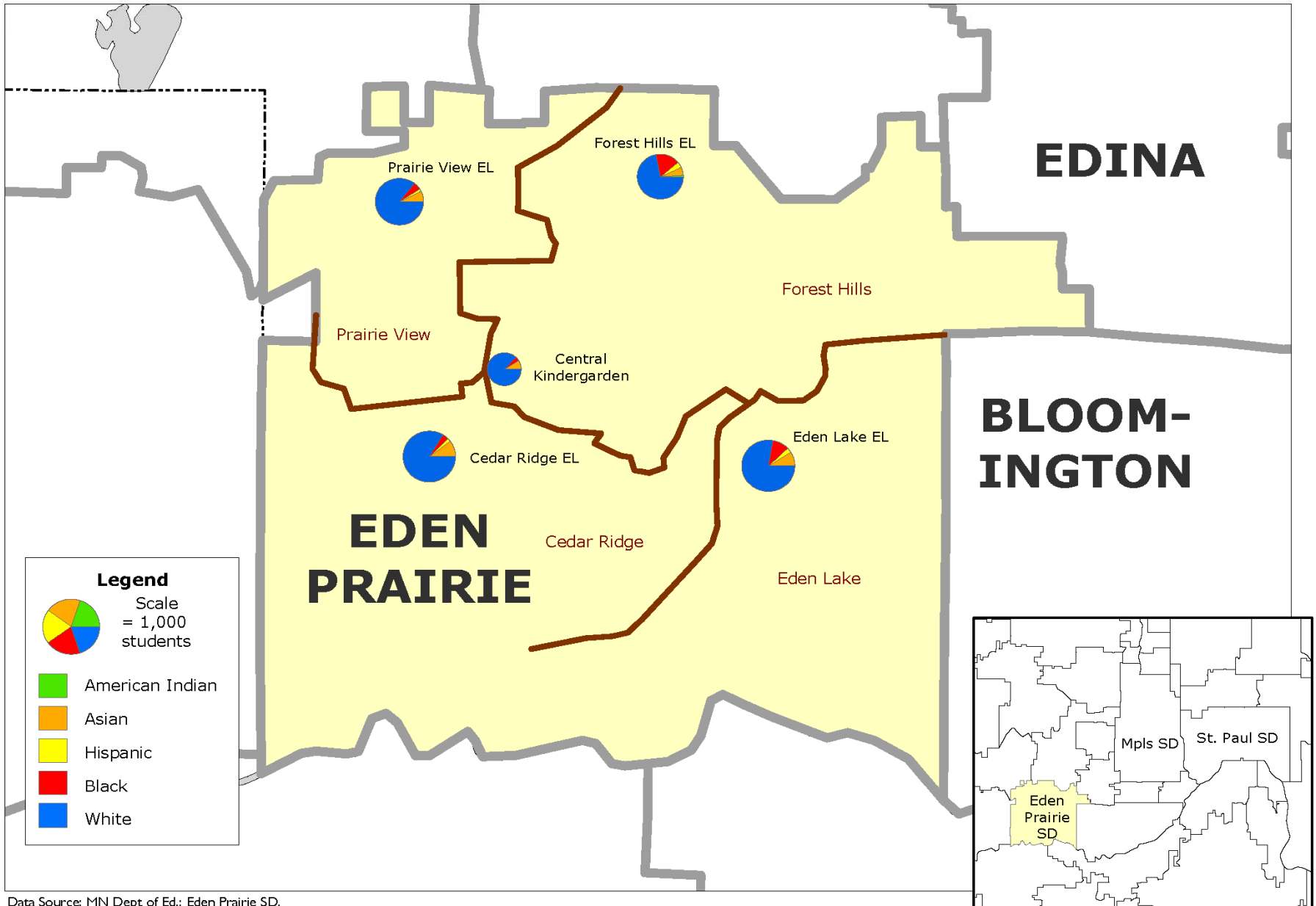

in the Rosemount-Apple Valley-Eagan School District, 2000**



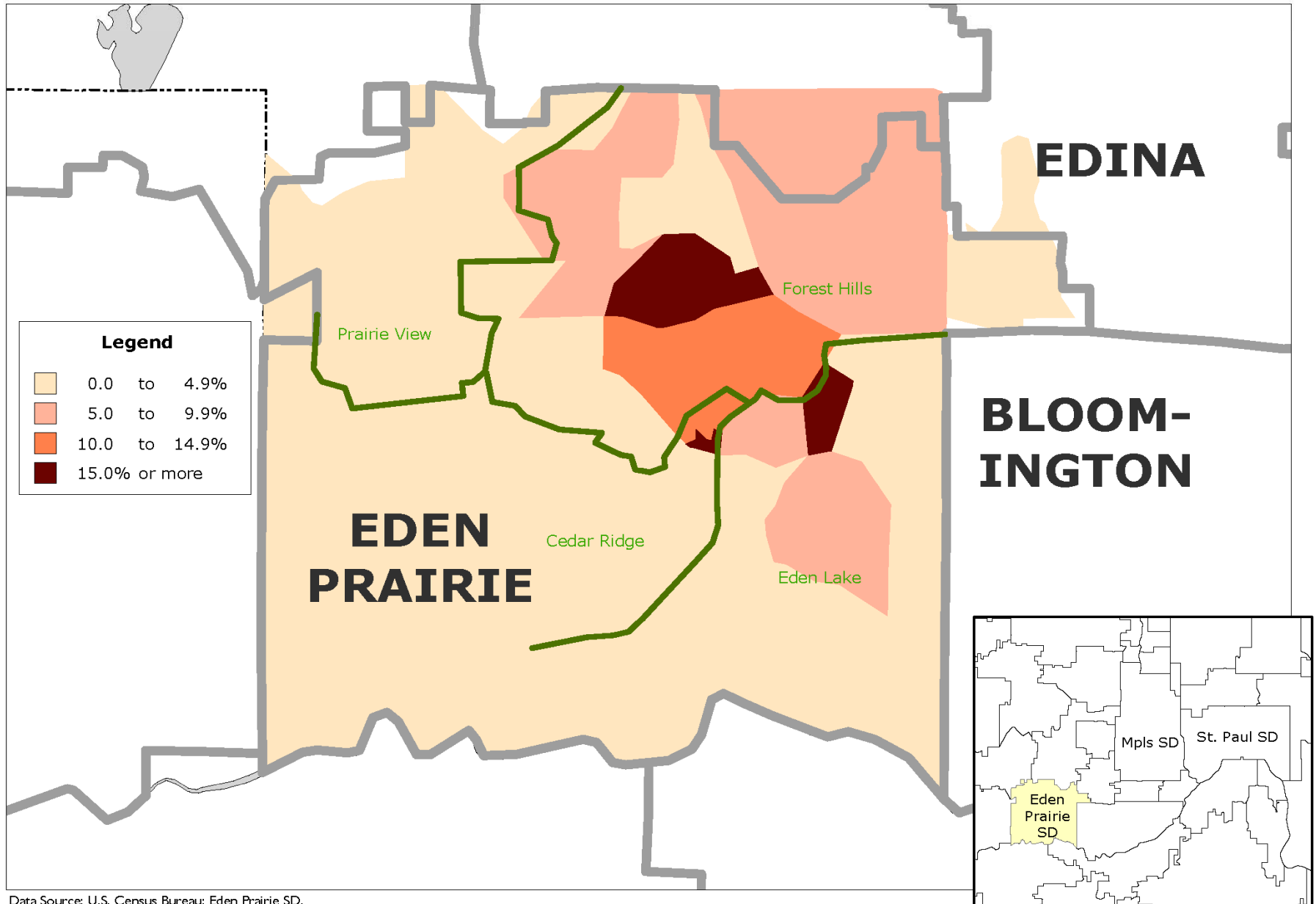

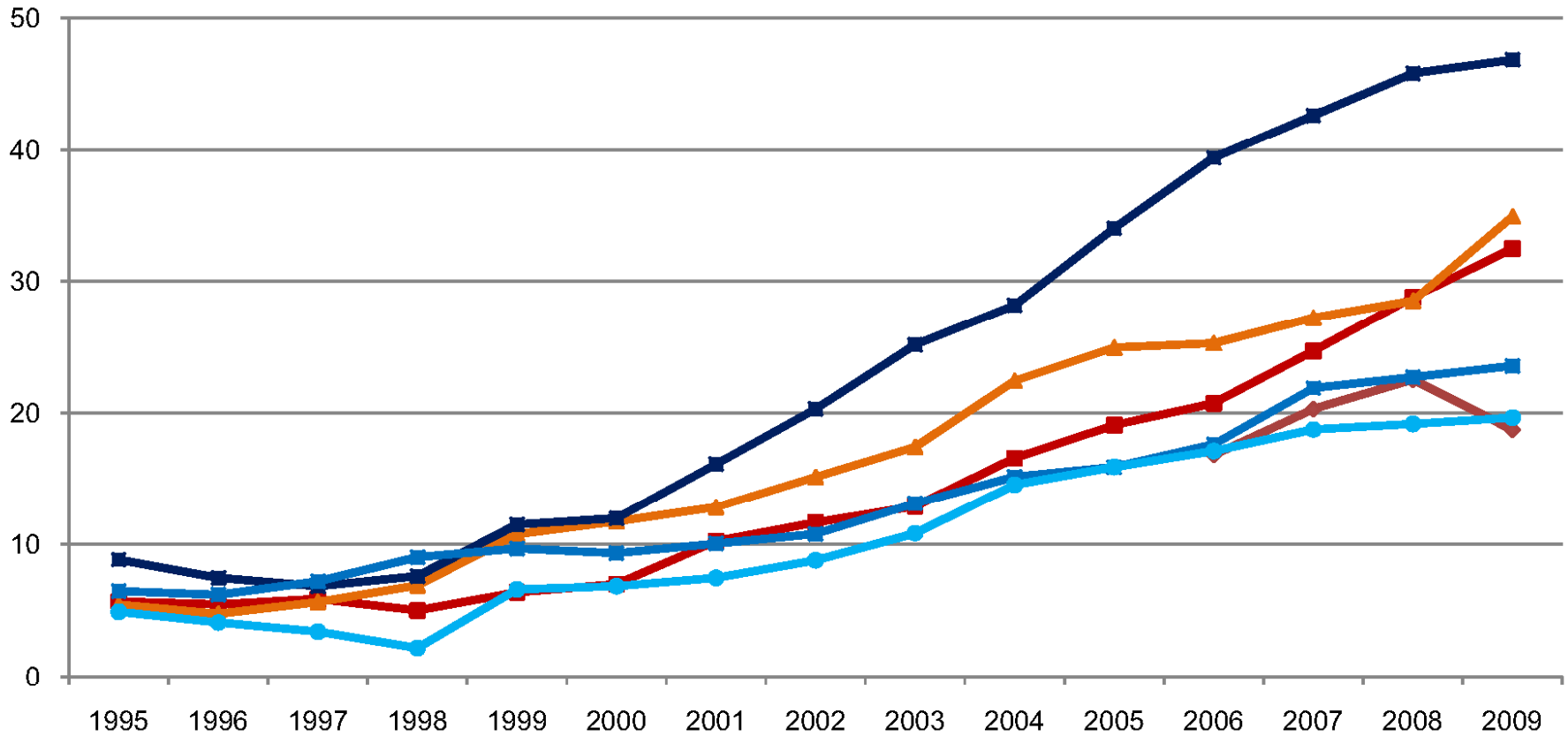

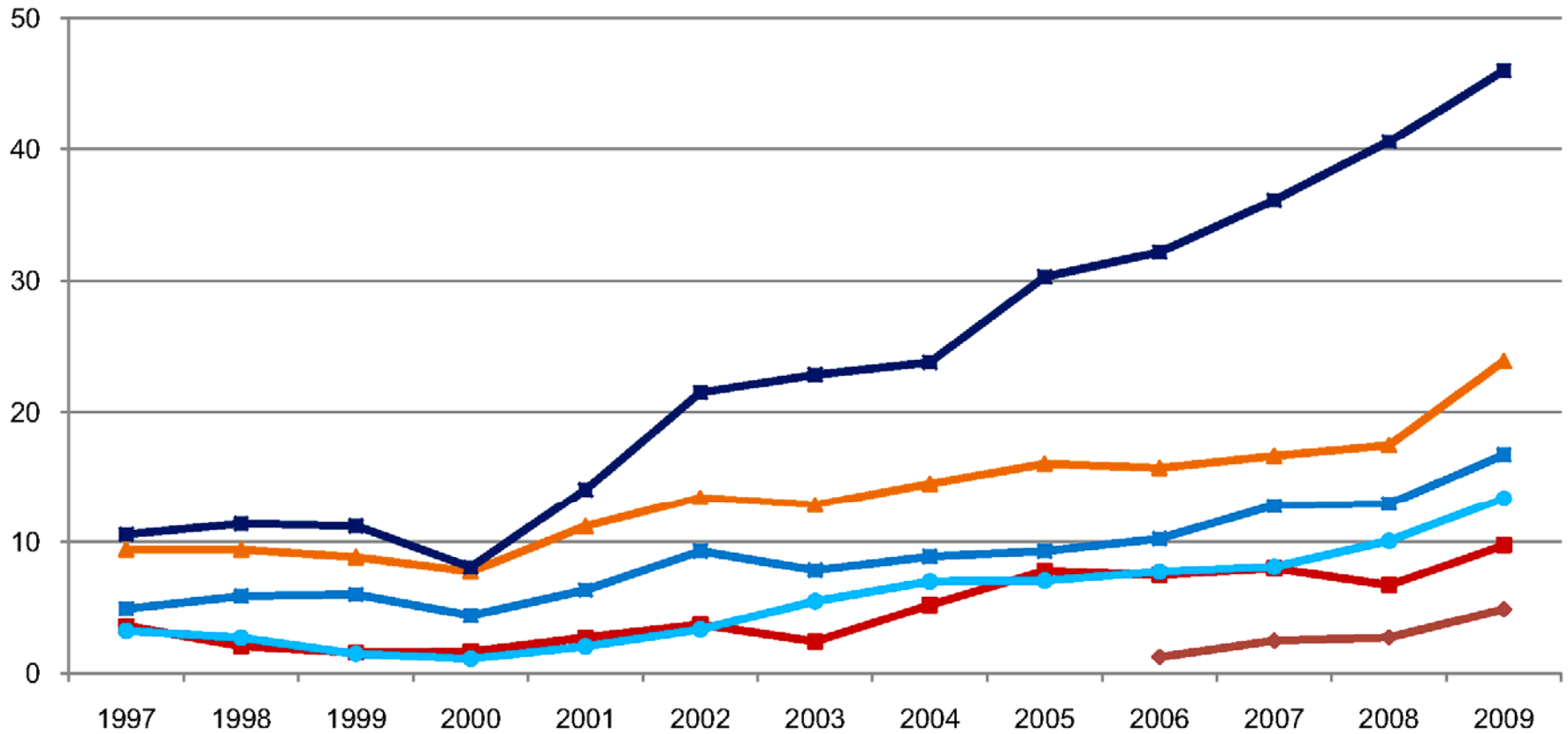

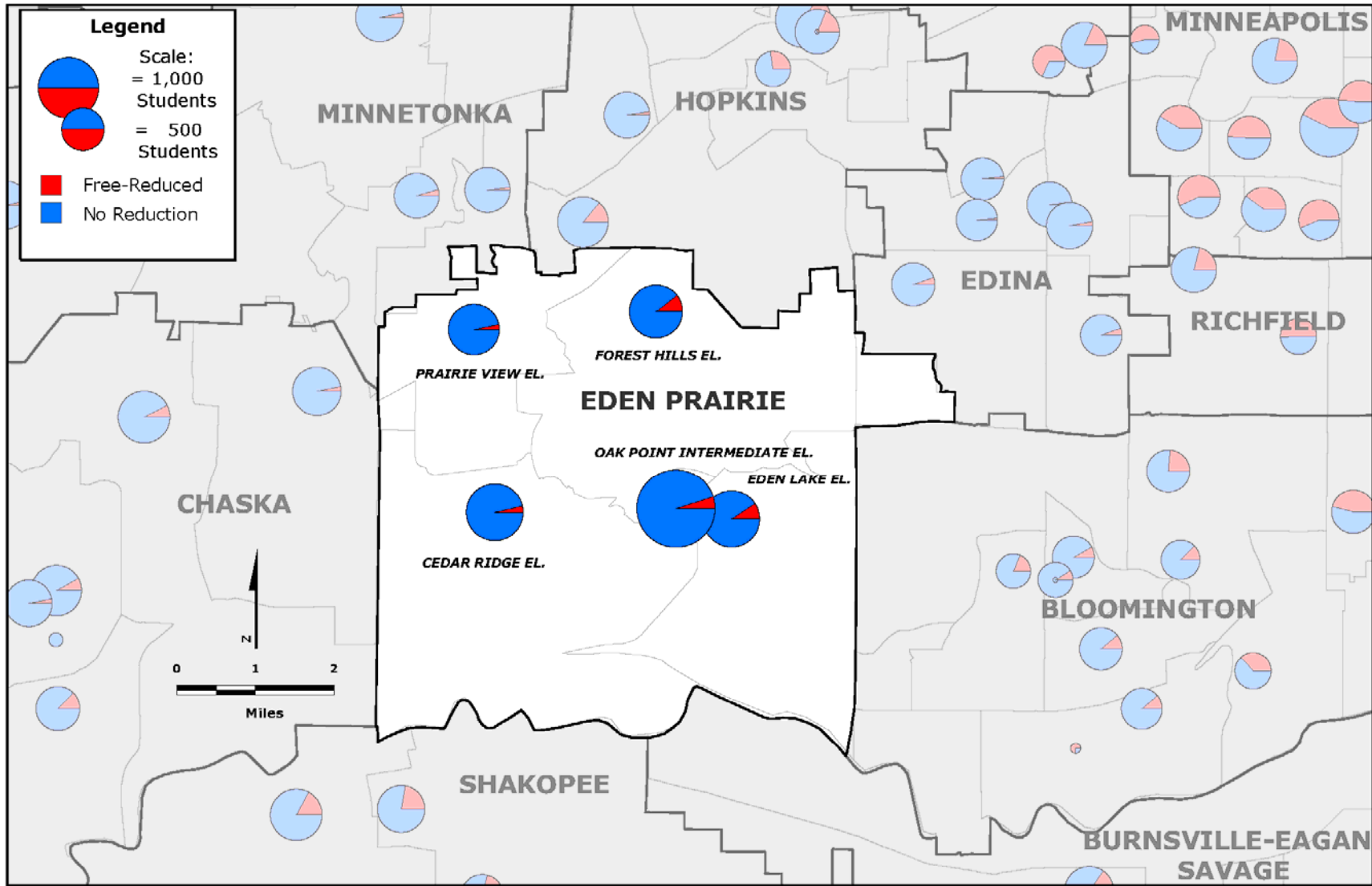

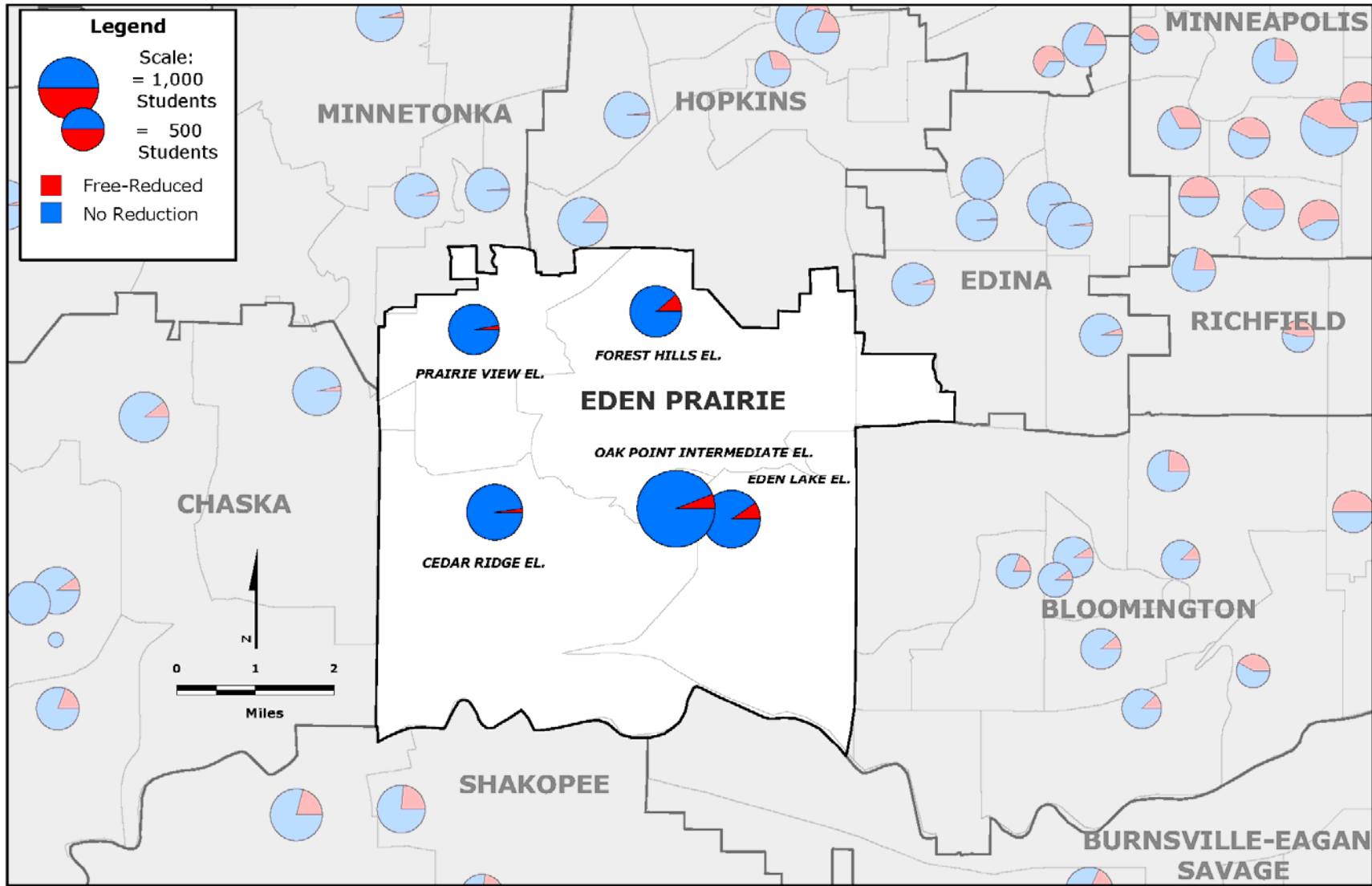

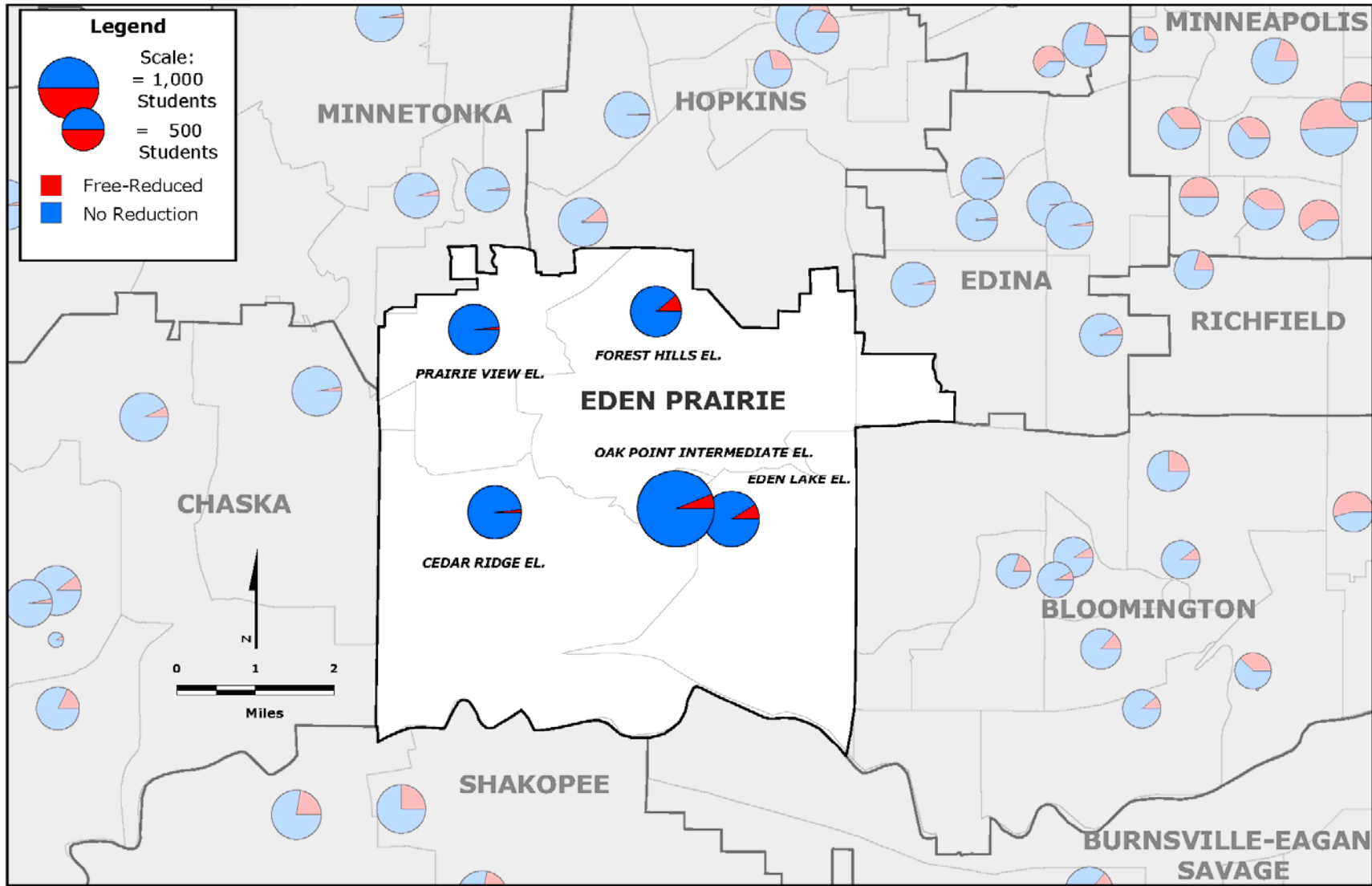

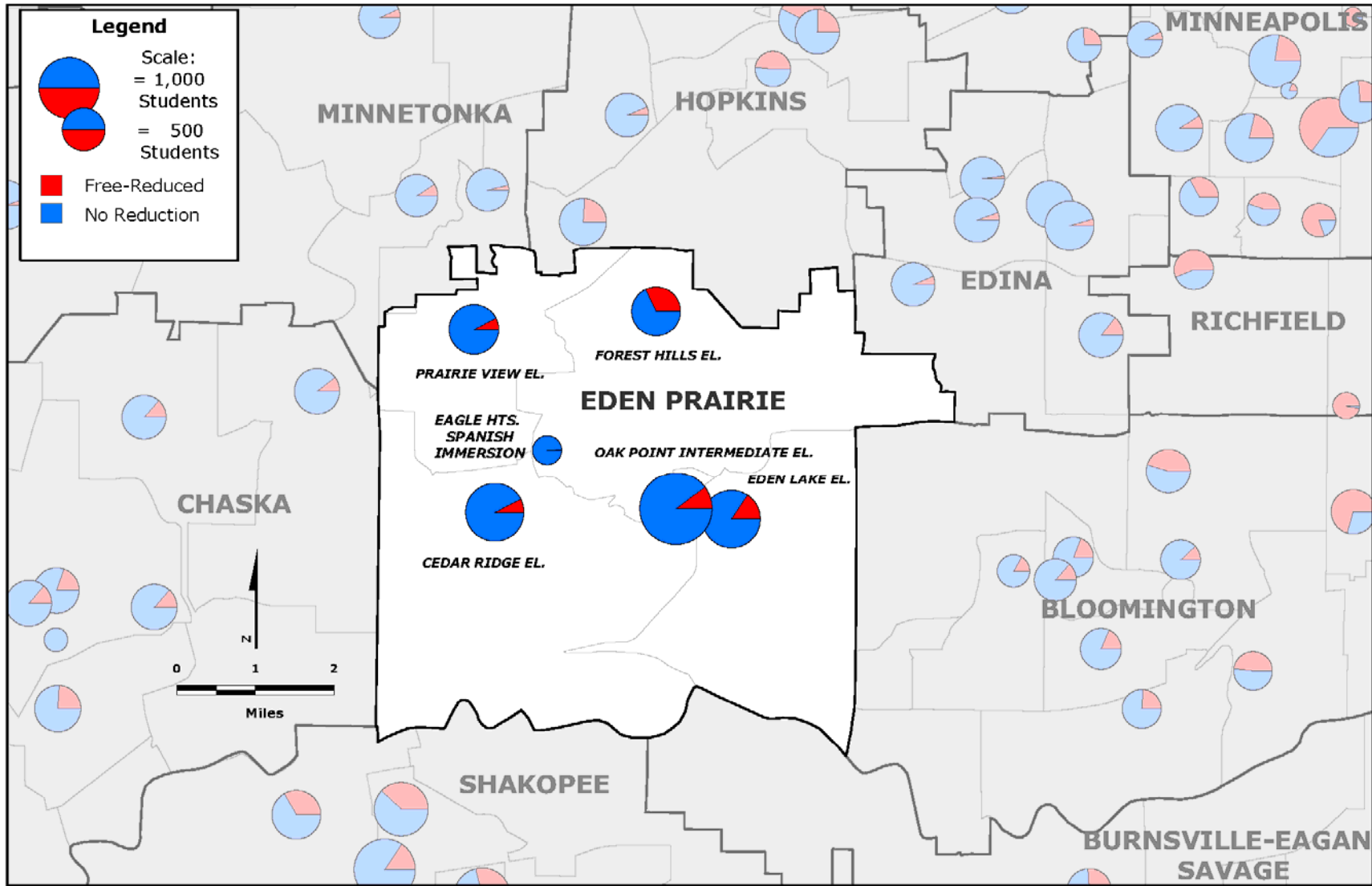

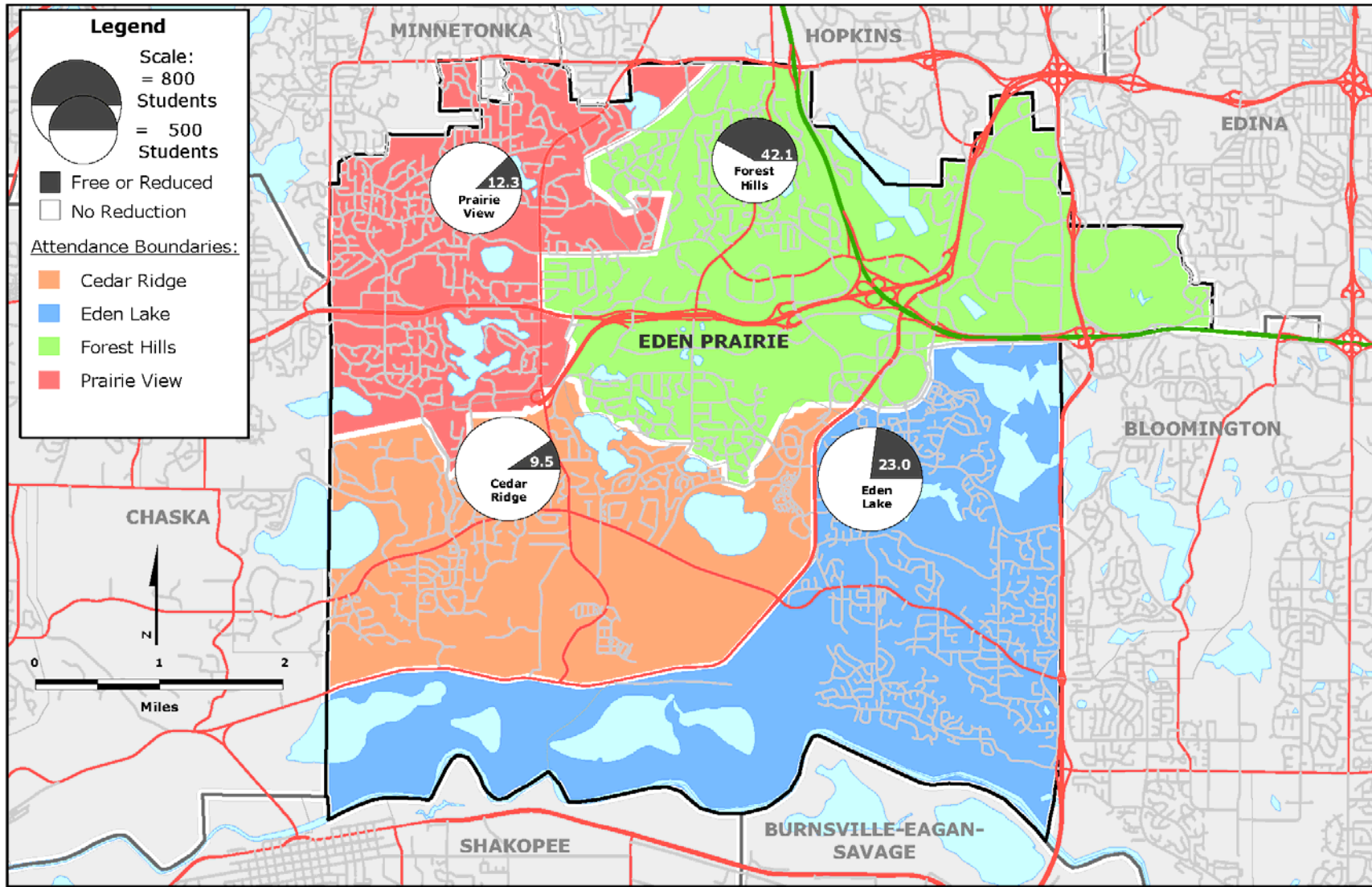

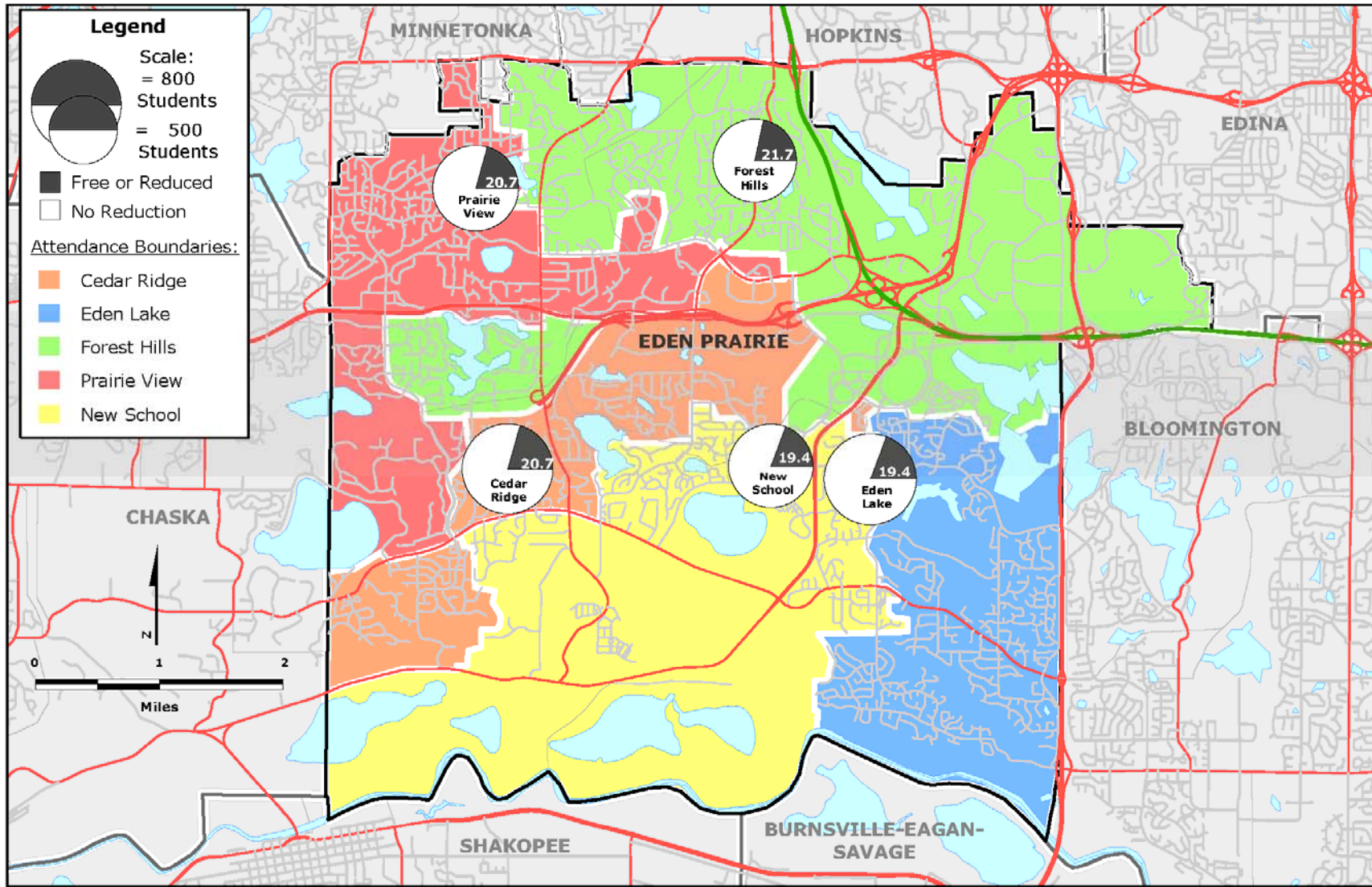
Free and Reduced Lunch in Current Configuration of Public Elementary Schools, 2010



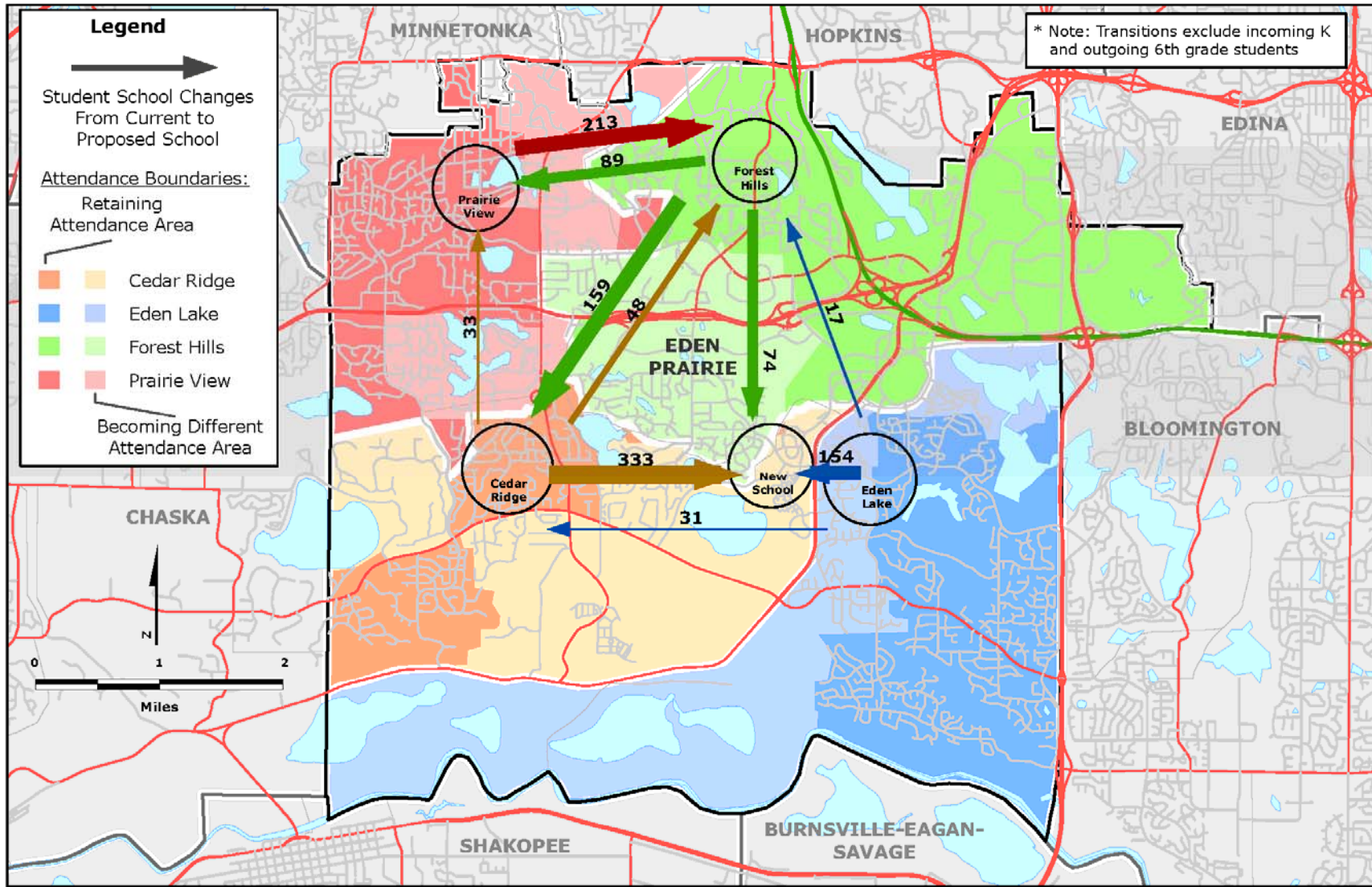

Free and Reduced Lunch in Proposed Configuration of Public Elementary Schools, 2011



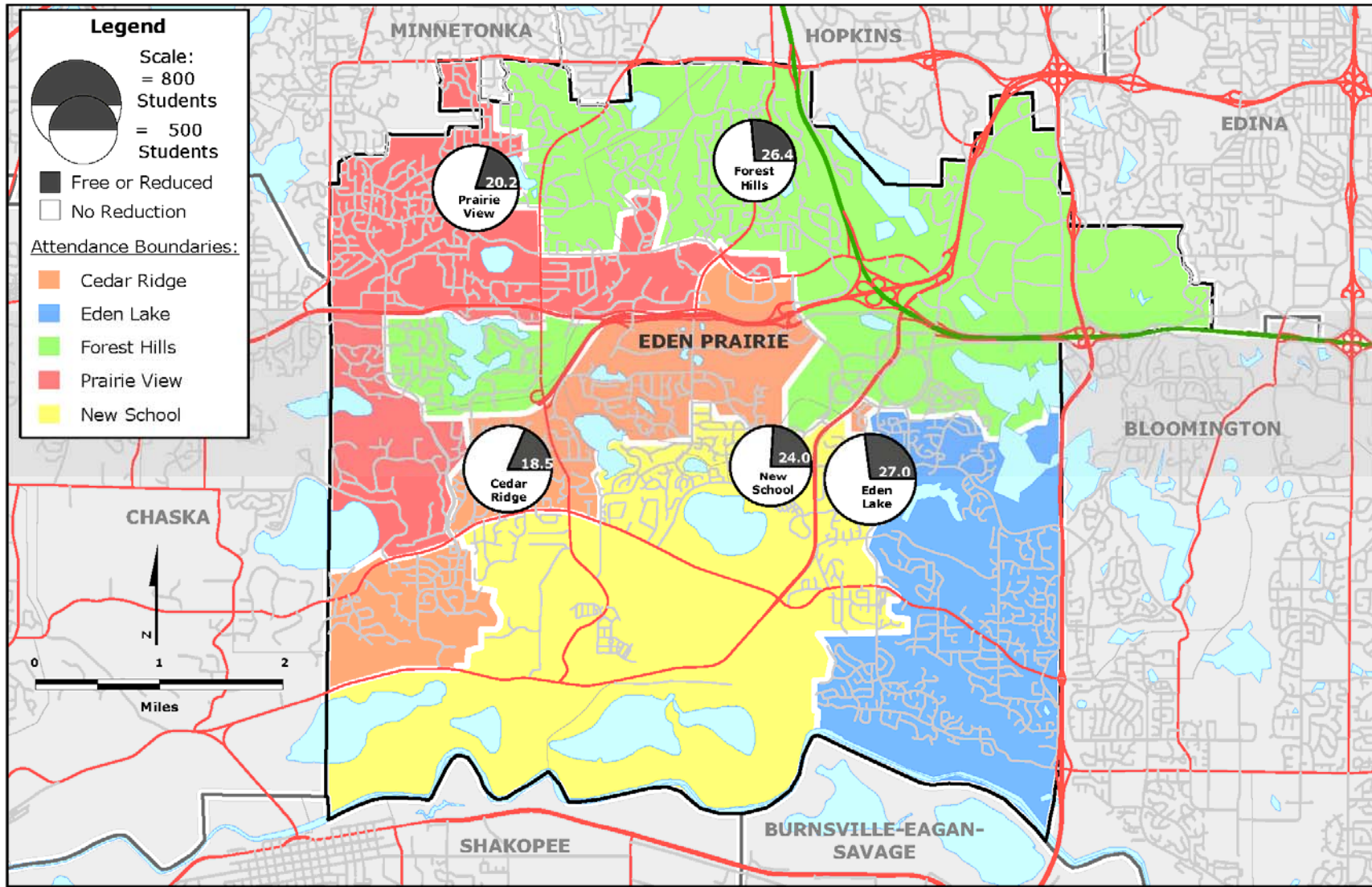

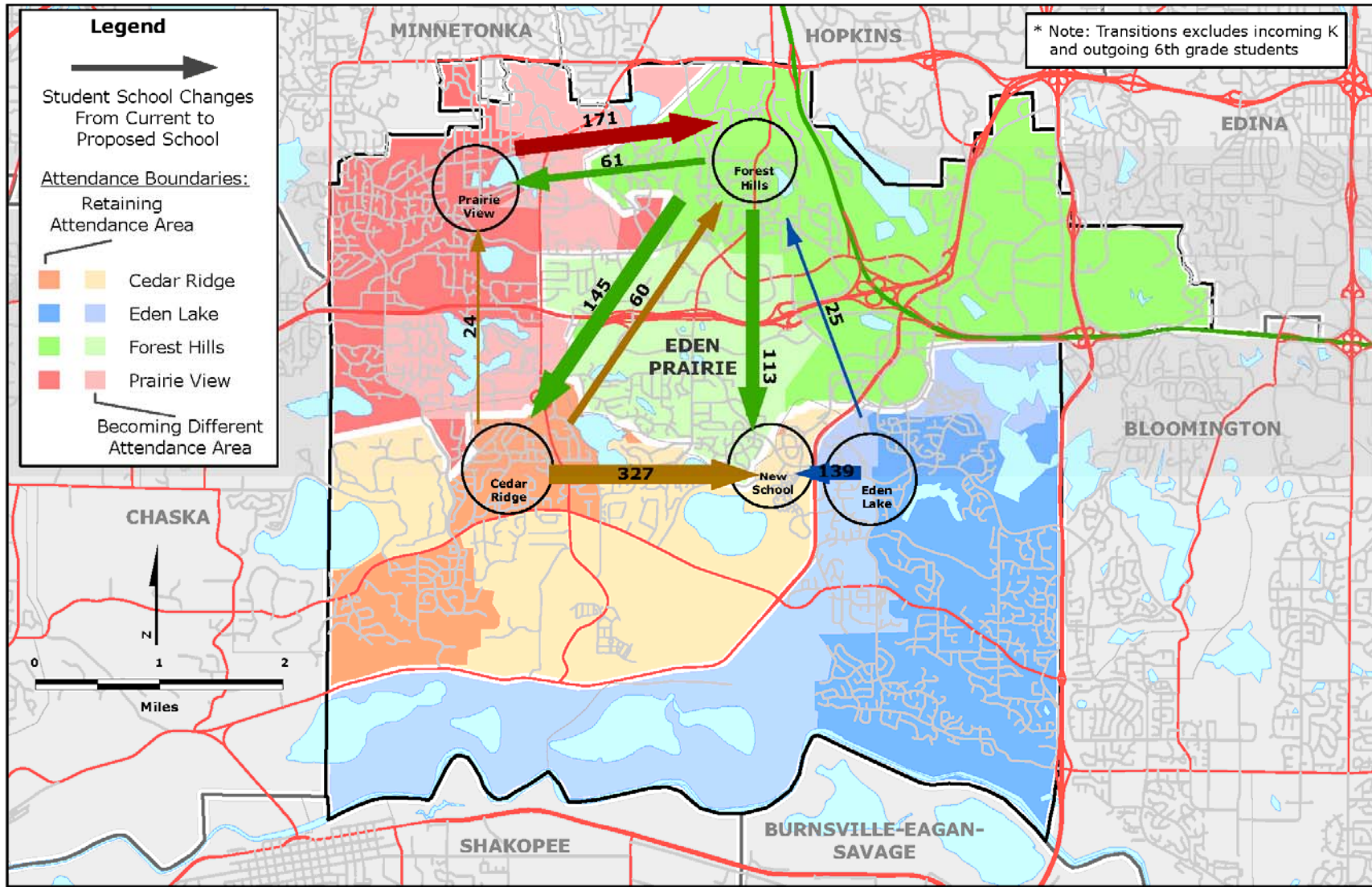

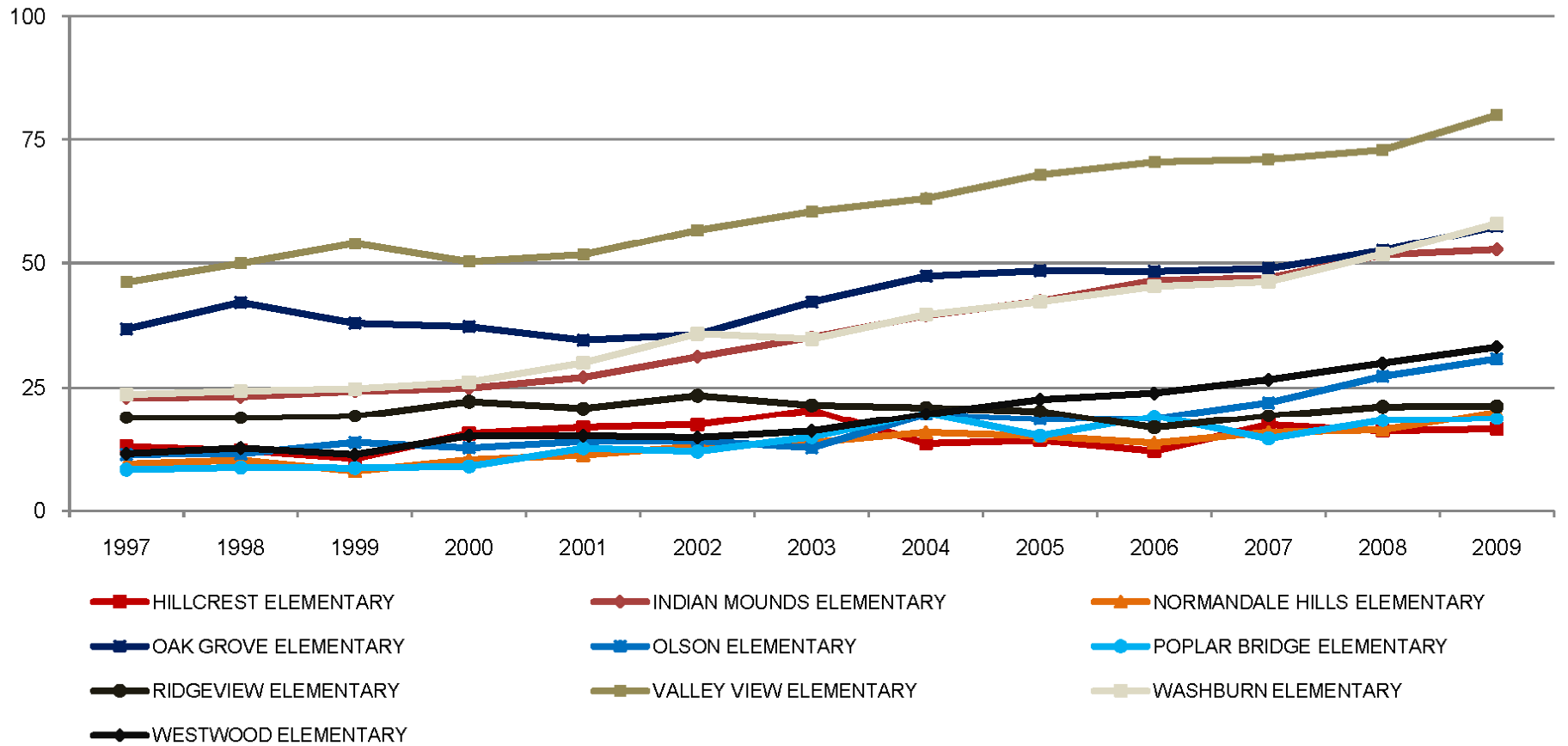

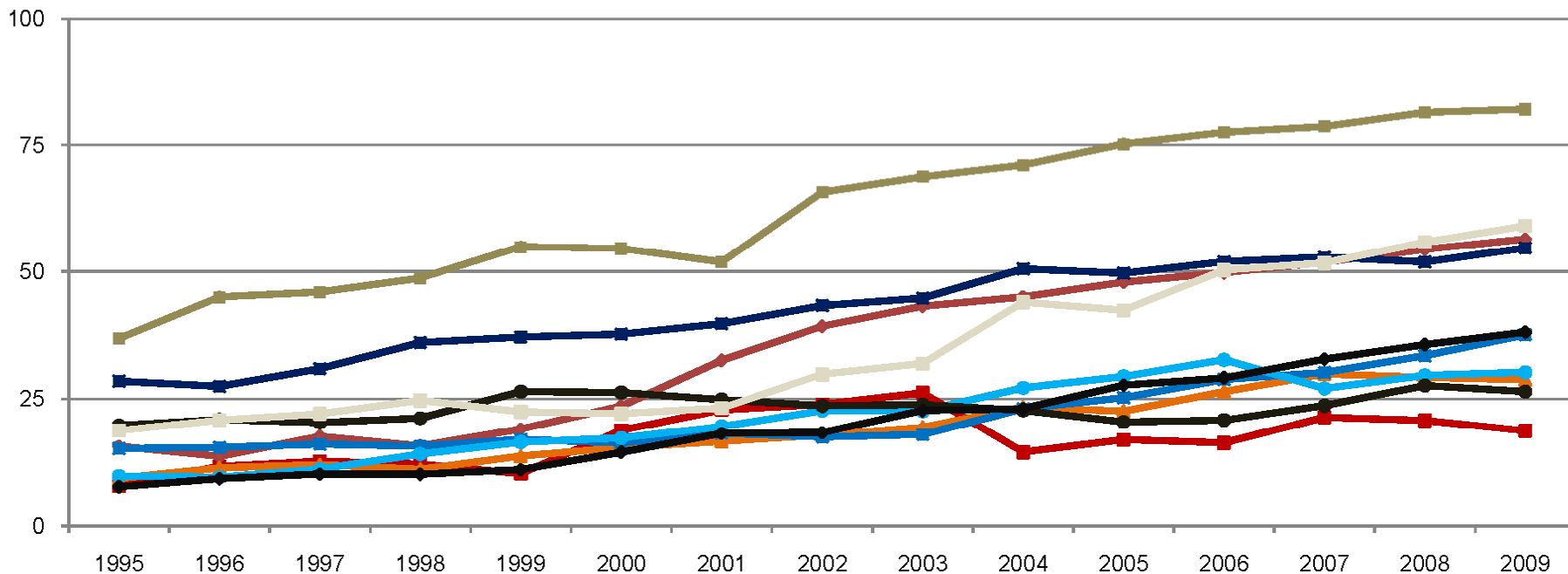

Percentage of Students Free/Reduced Price Lunch Eligible, 1995-96 - 2009-10**



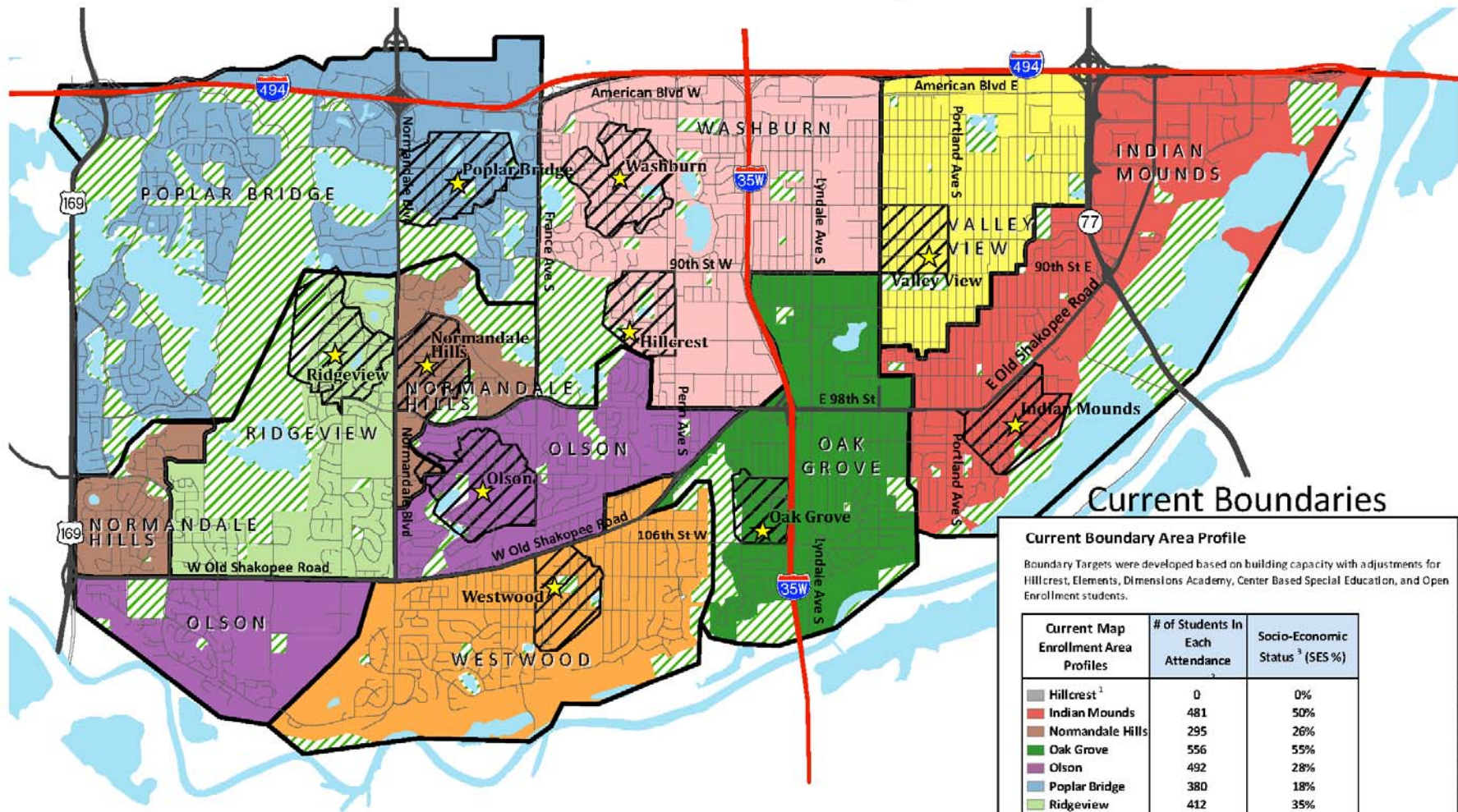

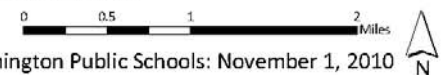

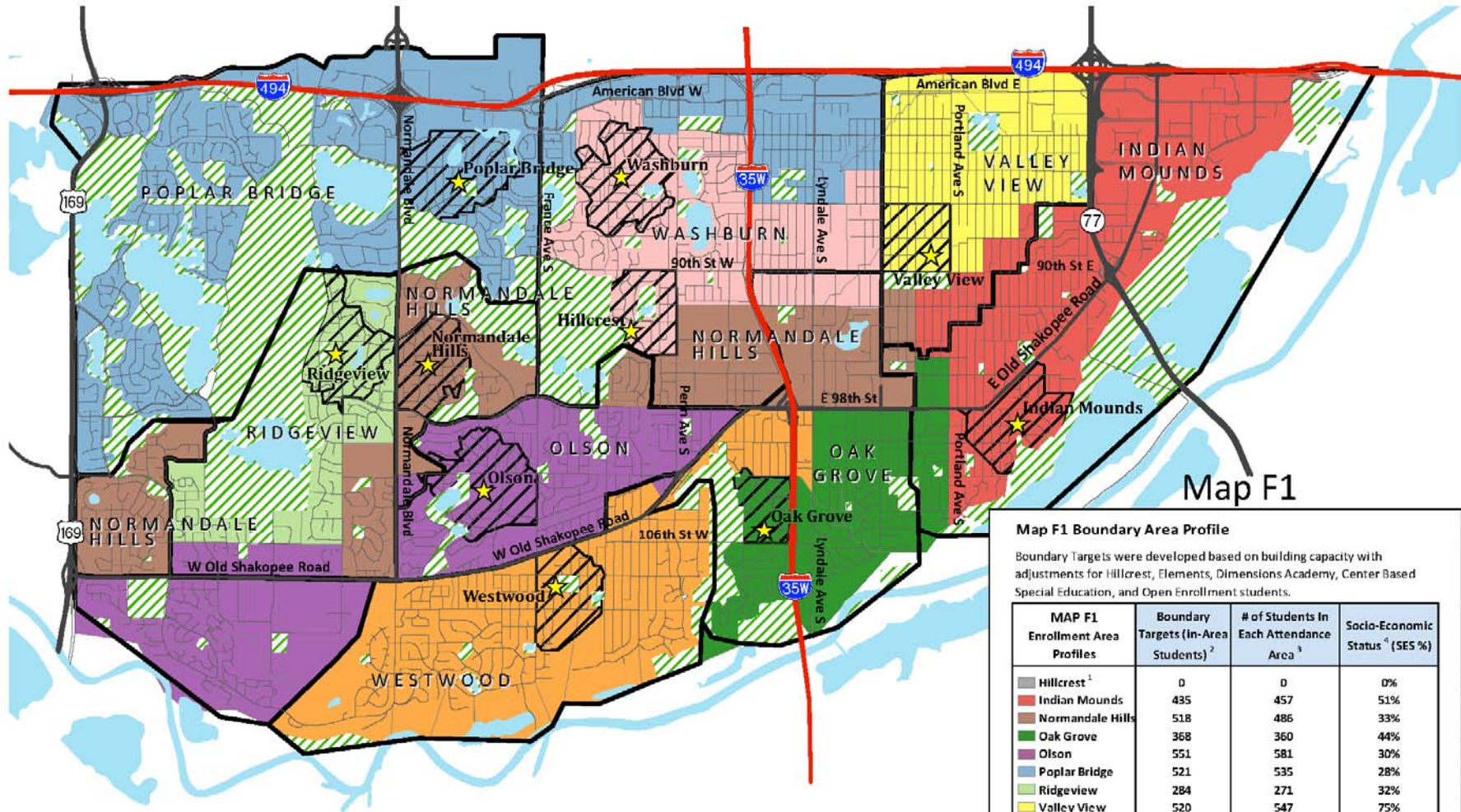
Maps A - E were used during the comment period. Maps F1 and F2 were developed after comments for presentation to the Board for the final selection.

Characteristics of the Proposals

- Maps A, B and C – variations which minimized changes from current map.
- Maps D and E – variations which attempted some balancing by race and poverty.
- Maps F and G – variations which resulted from community input sessions. Most similar to A-C, but with less equalizing than A-C.
- Final selection was F2 (with minor changes)—the least equalizing option among all of the considered maps.

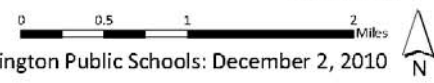

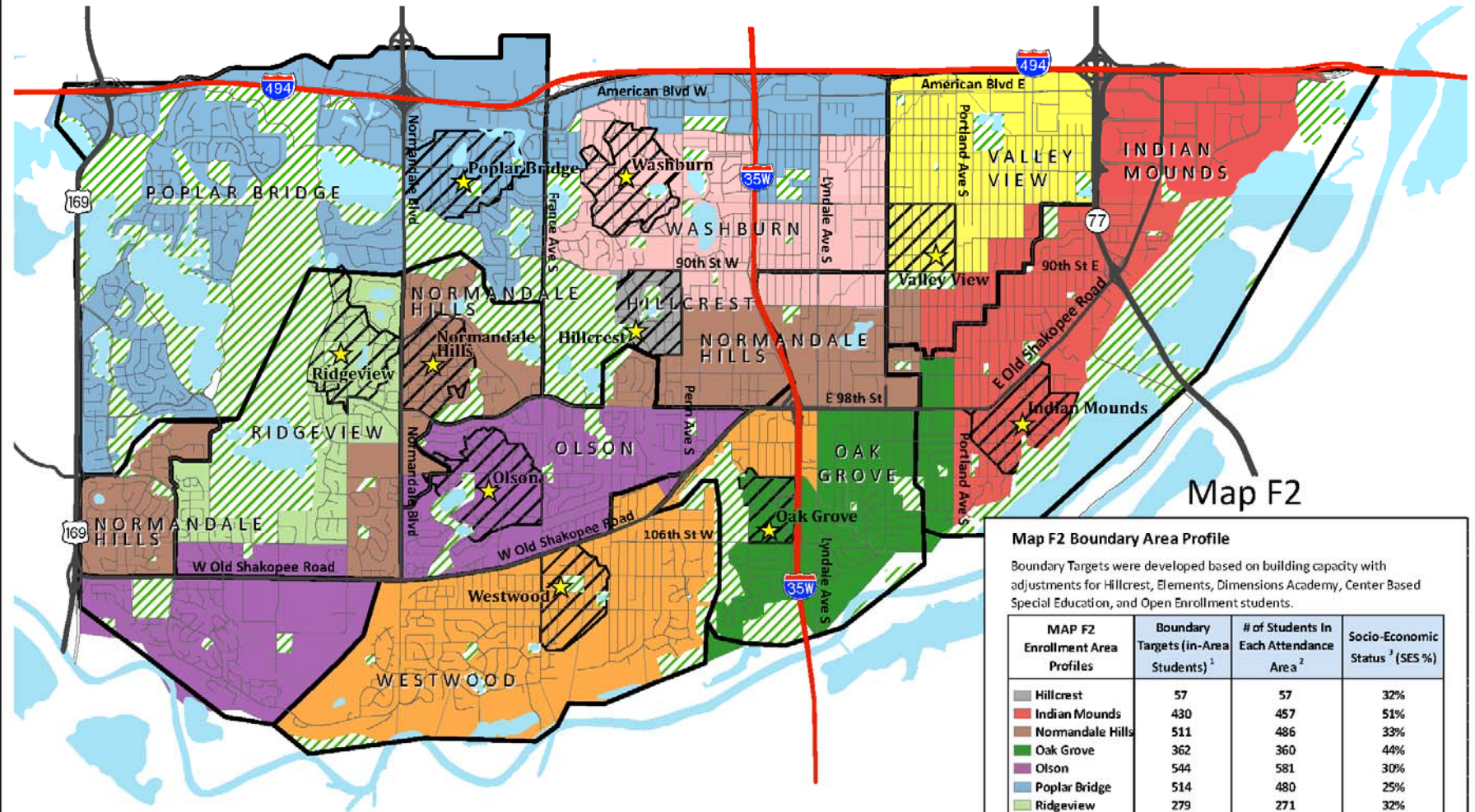

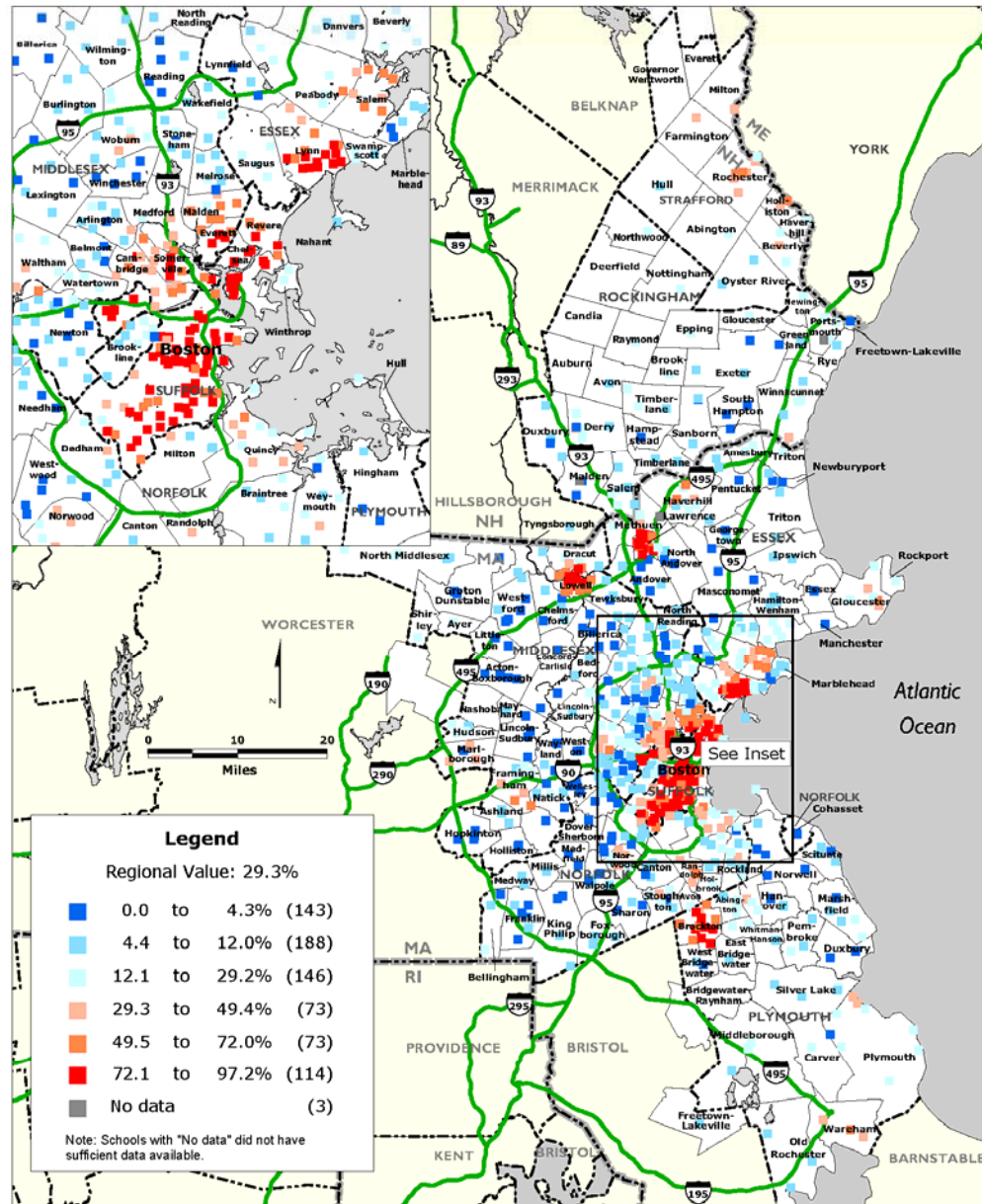

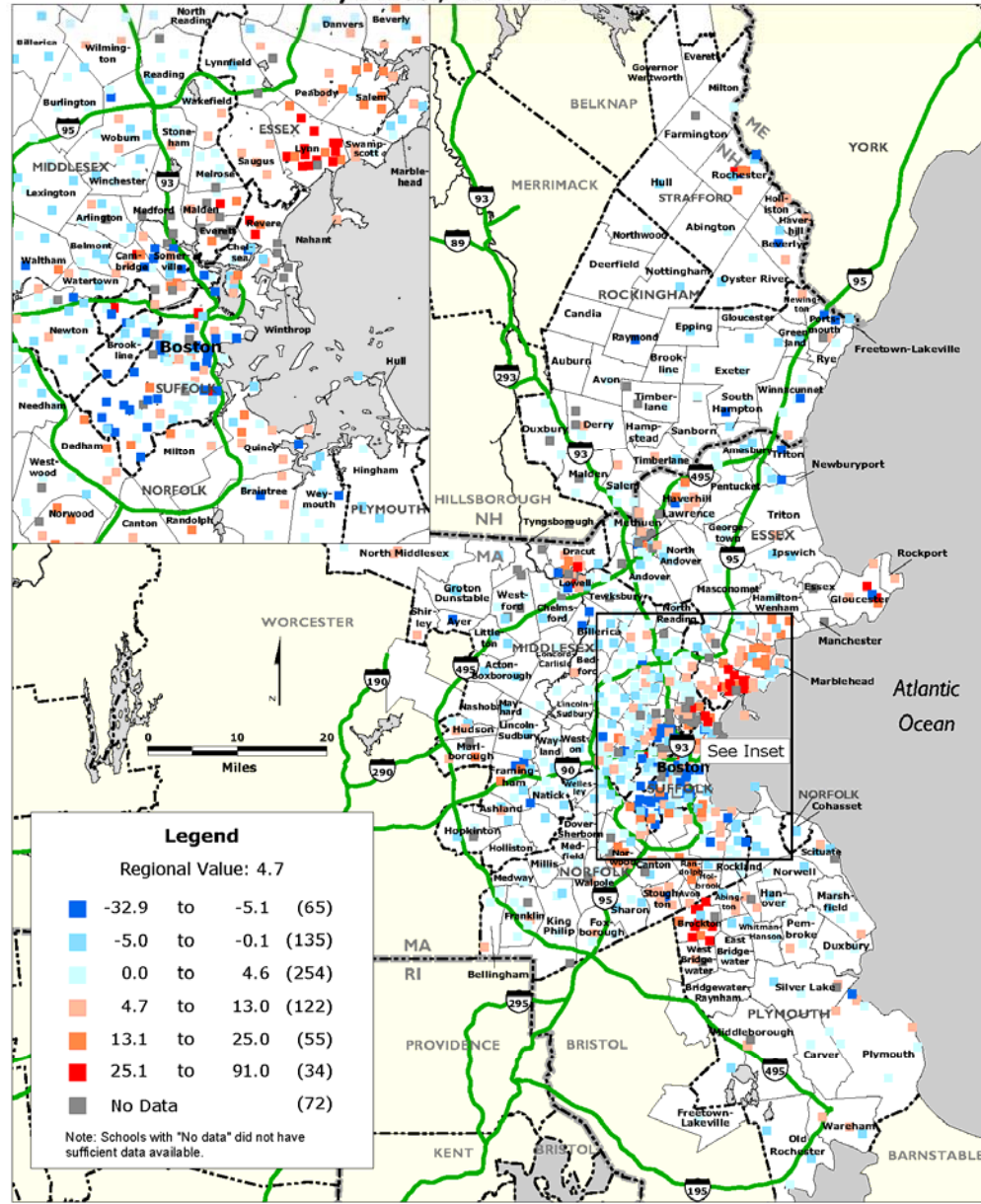

BOSTON REGION Percentage of Elementary Students Eligible for Free or Reduced Lunch by School, 2009

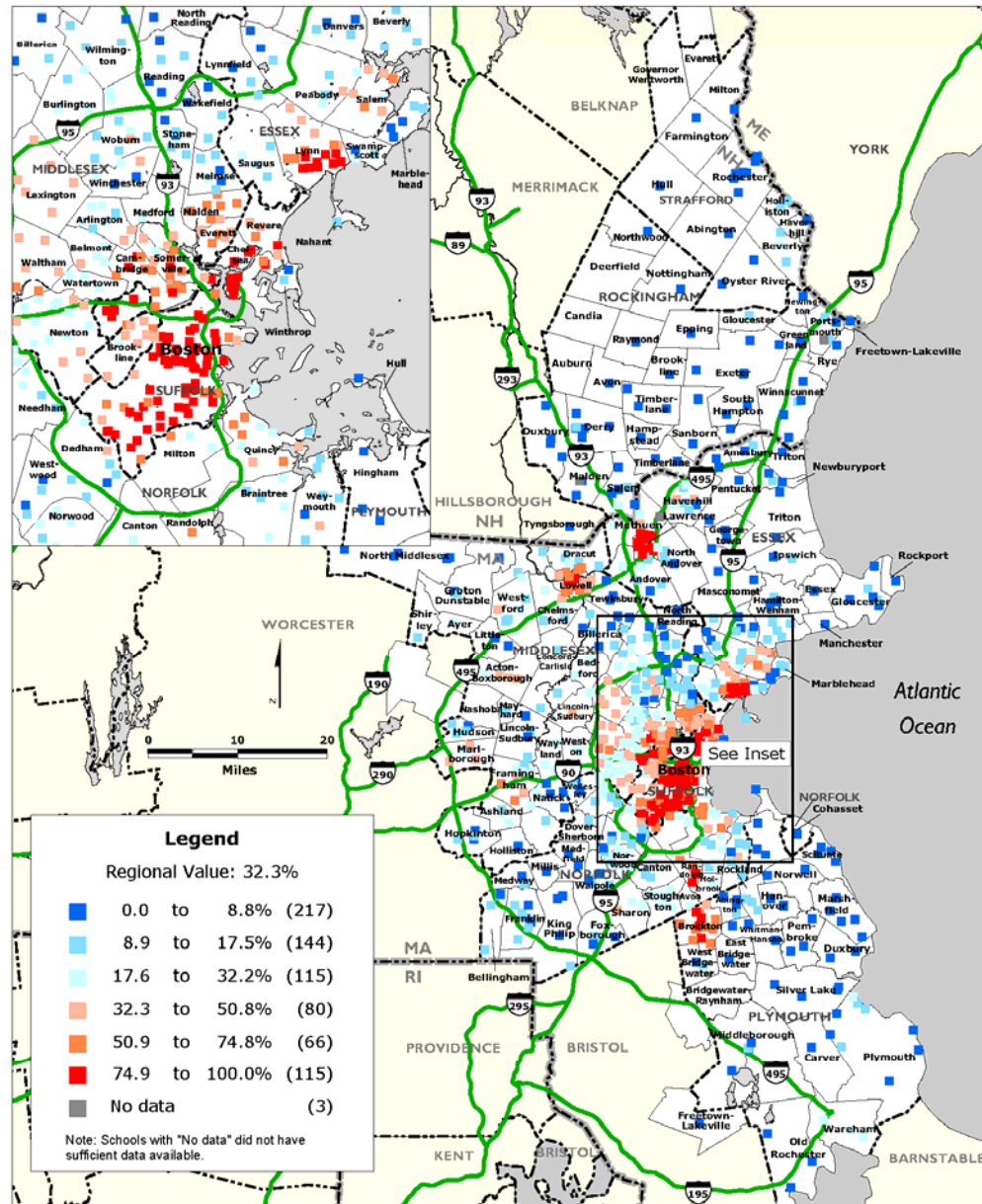

BOSTON REGION Percentage Point Change in the Share of Elementary Students Eligible for Free or Reduced Lunch by School, 2000-2009

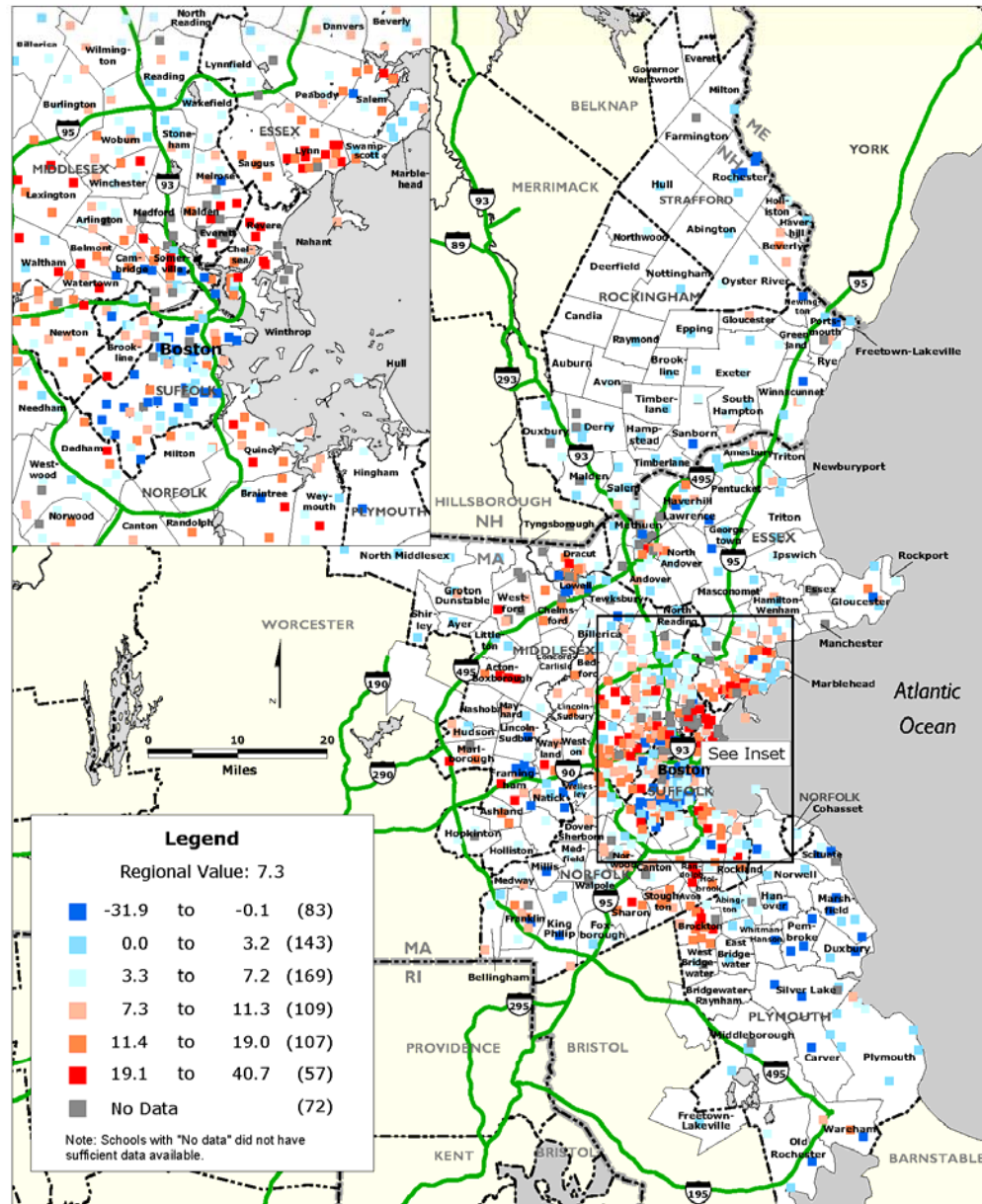


BOSTON REGION Percentage Minority Elementary Students by School, 2009



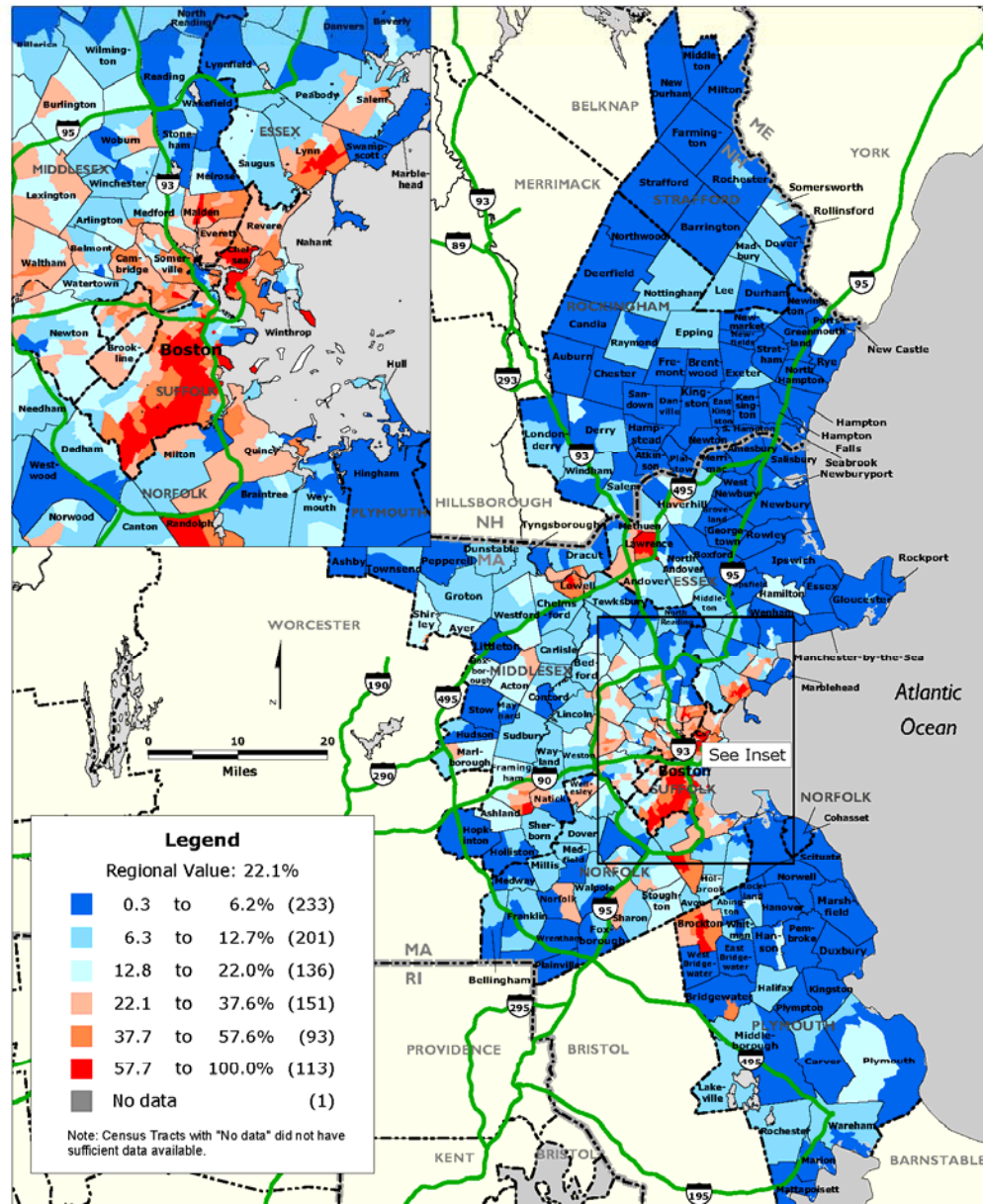

BOSTON REGION Percentage Point Change in the Share of Minority Elementary Students by School, 2000-2009



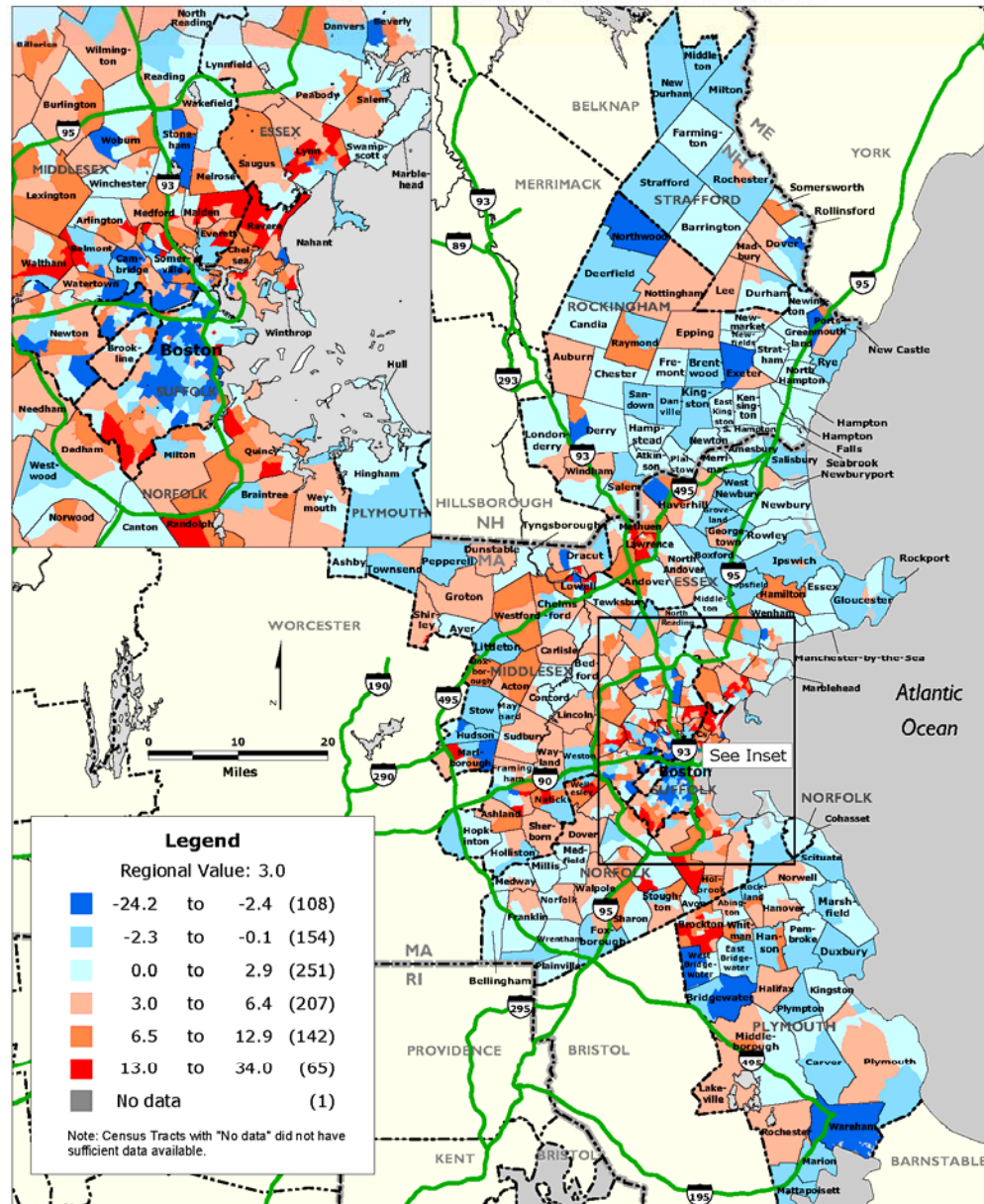

BOSTON REGION: Percentage Minority Population by Census Tract, 2005-2009



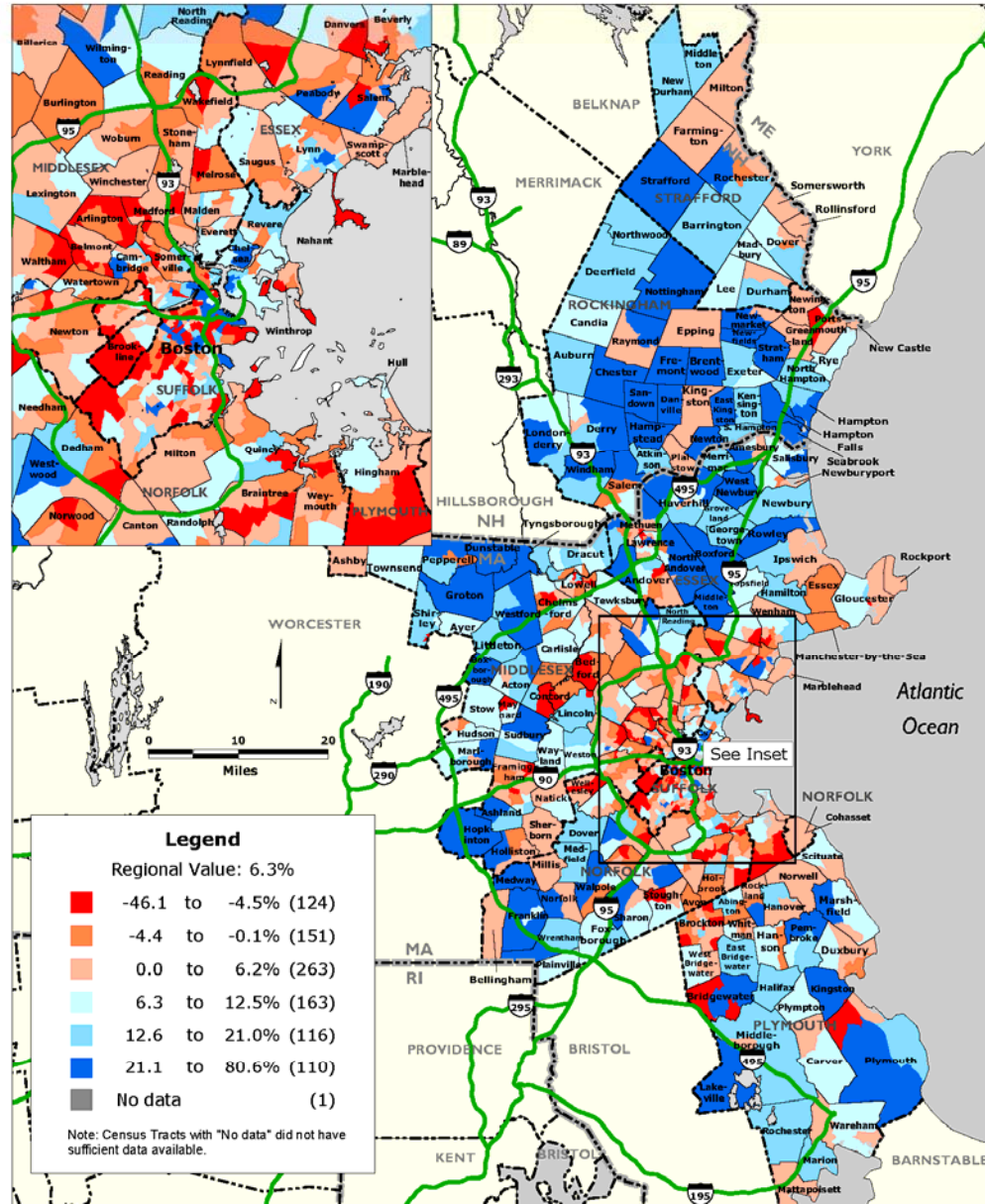

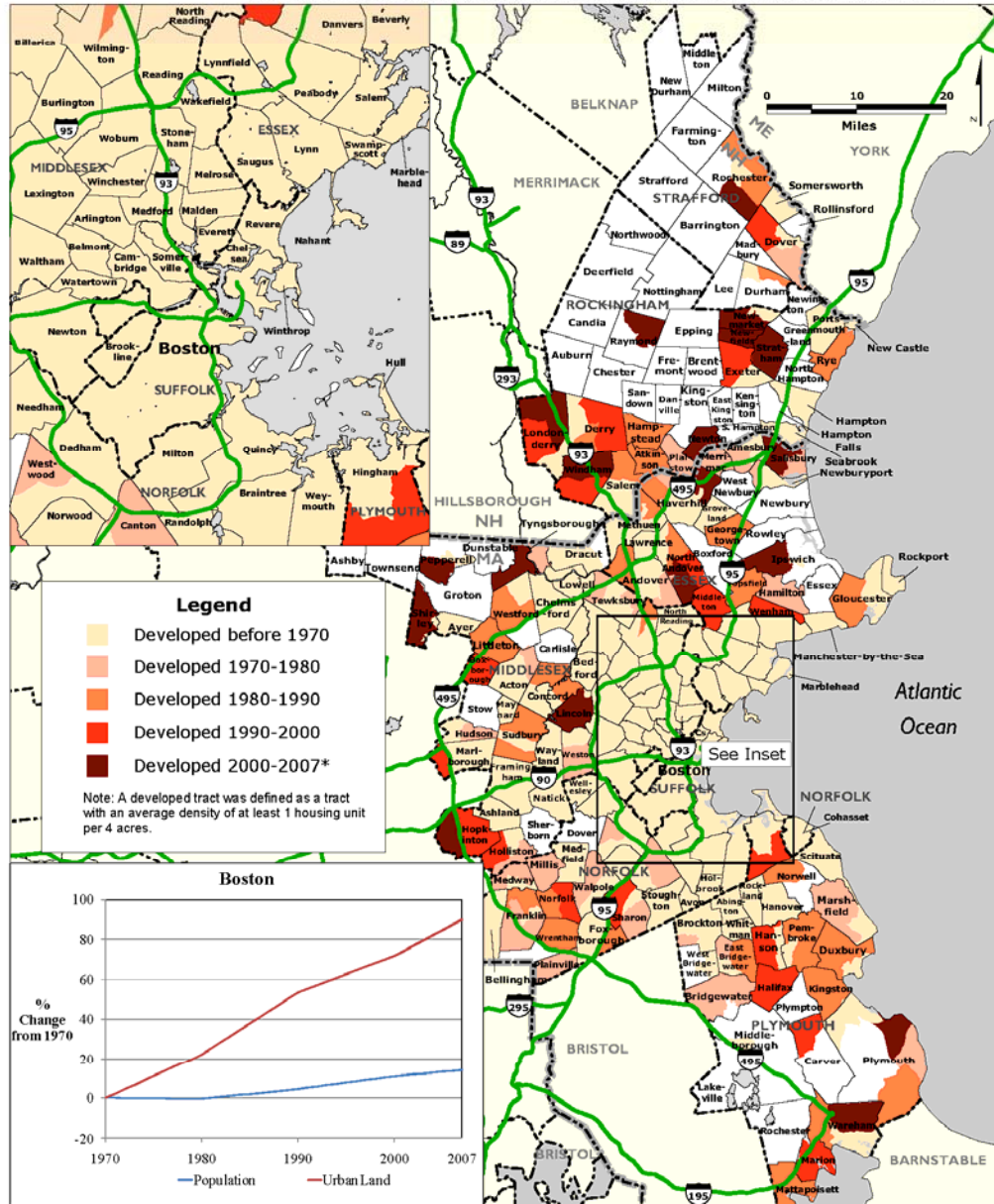
BOSTON REGION: Percentage Change in Population by Census Tract, 1990-2000

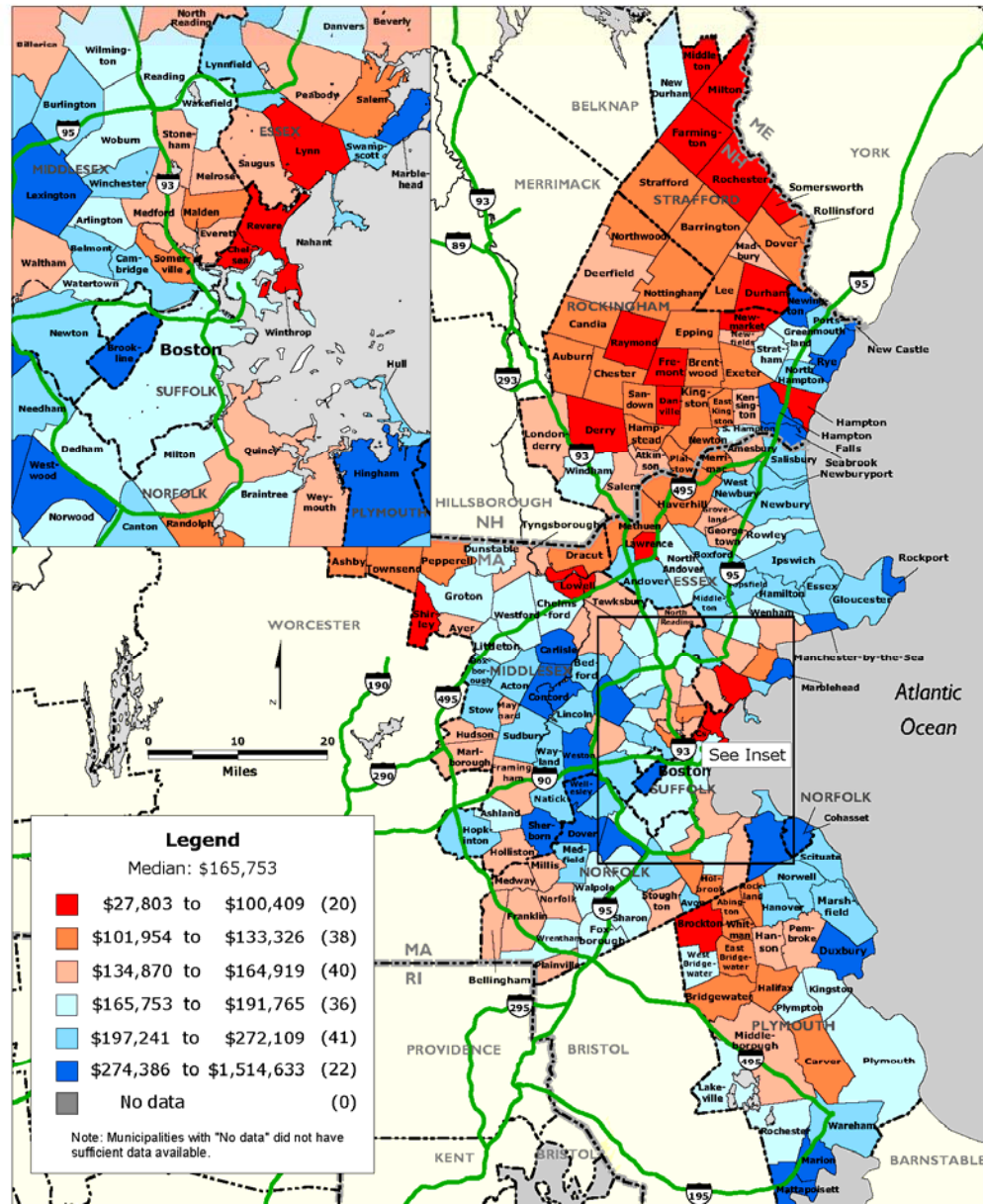
BOSTON REGION: Urban Land by Census Tract, 1970 to 2007*

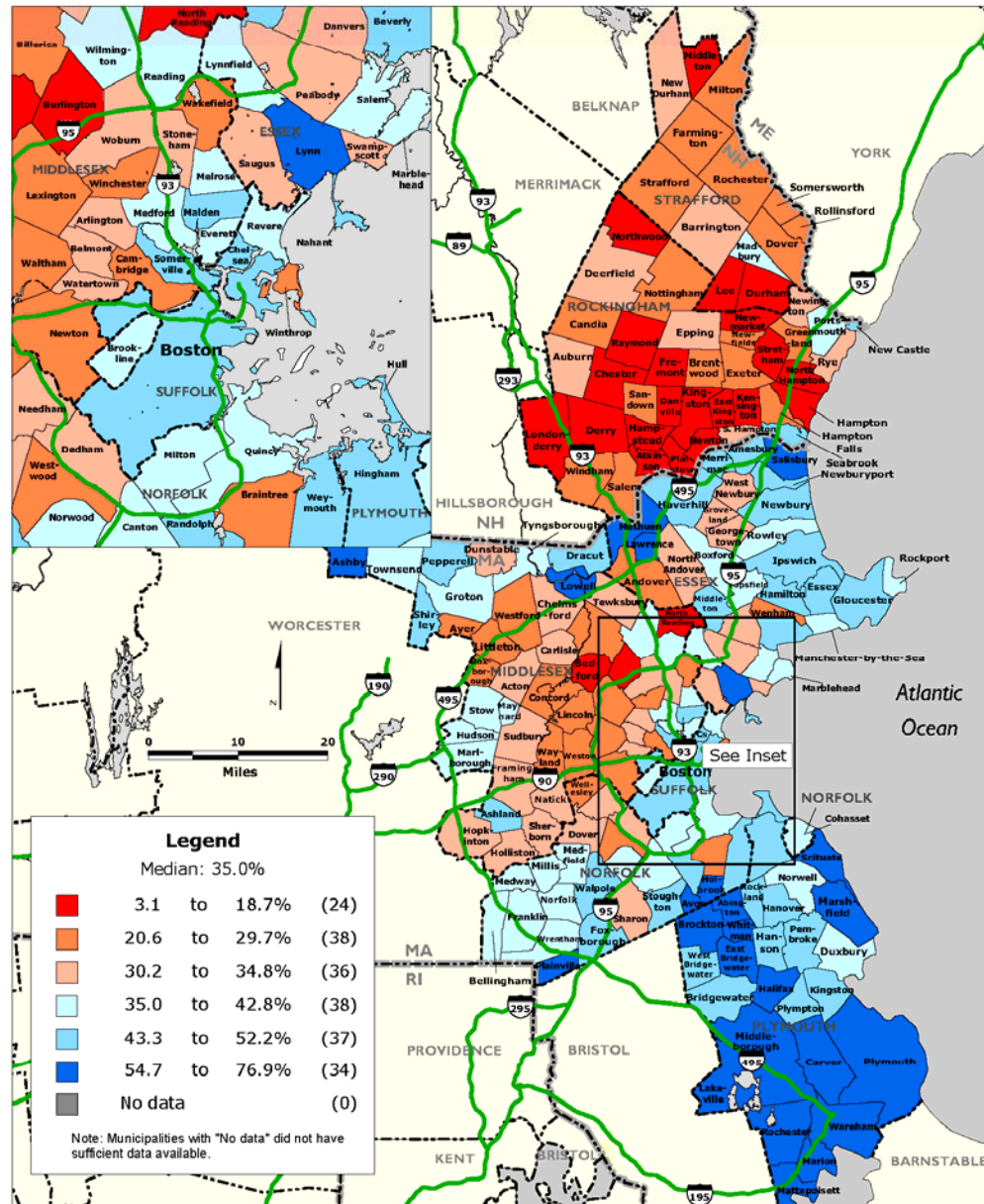

BOSTON REGION Market Value of Property Per Capita by Municipality, 2008



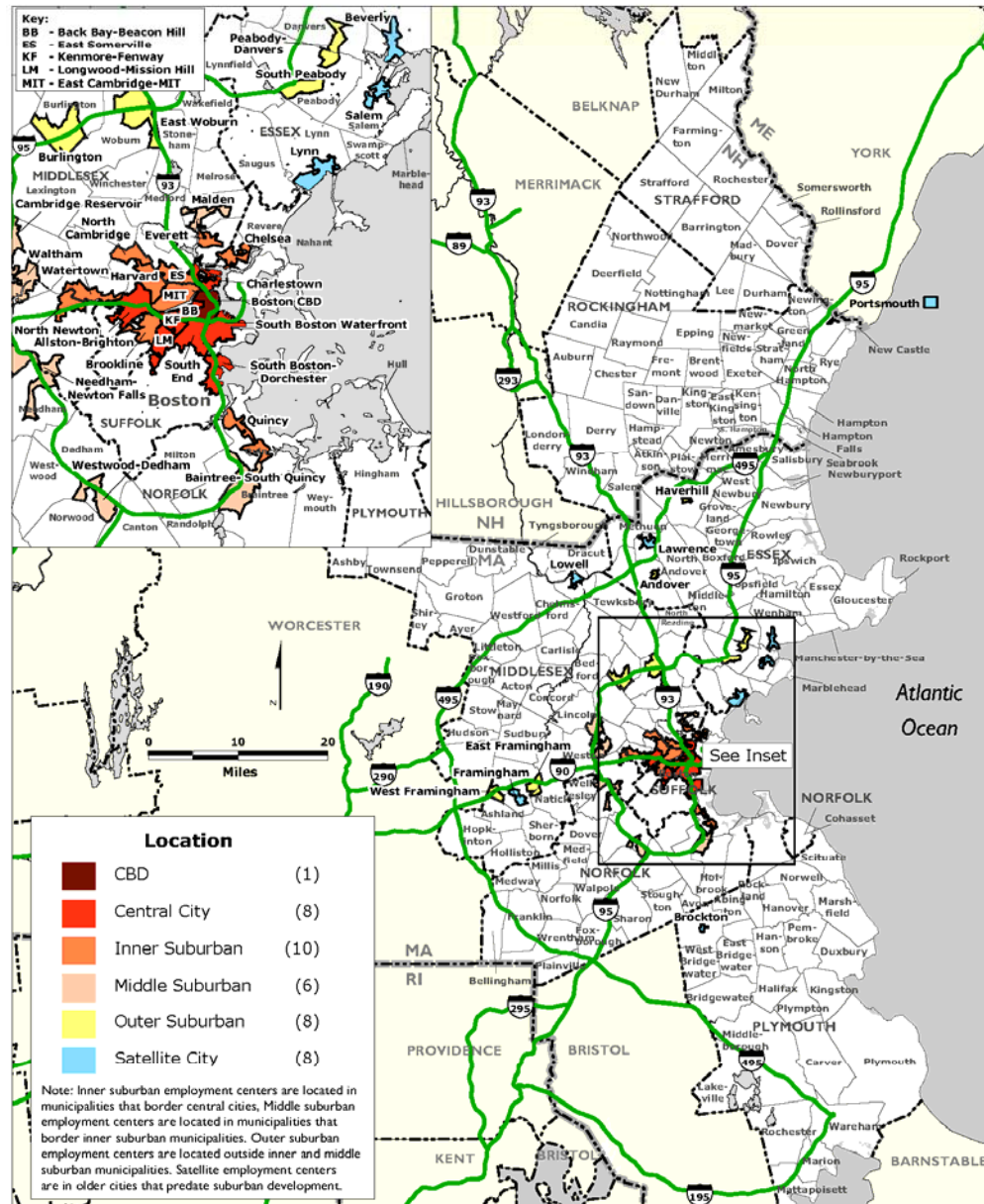

BOSTON REGION Percentage Change in Market Value of Property Per Capita by Municipality, 2003-2008

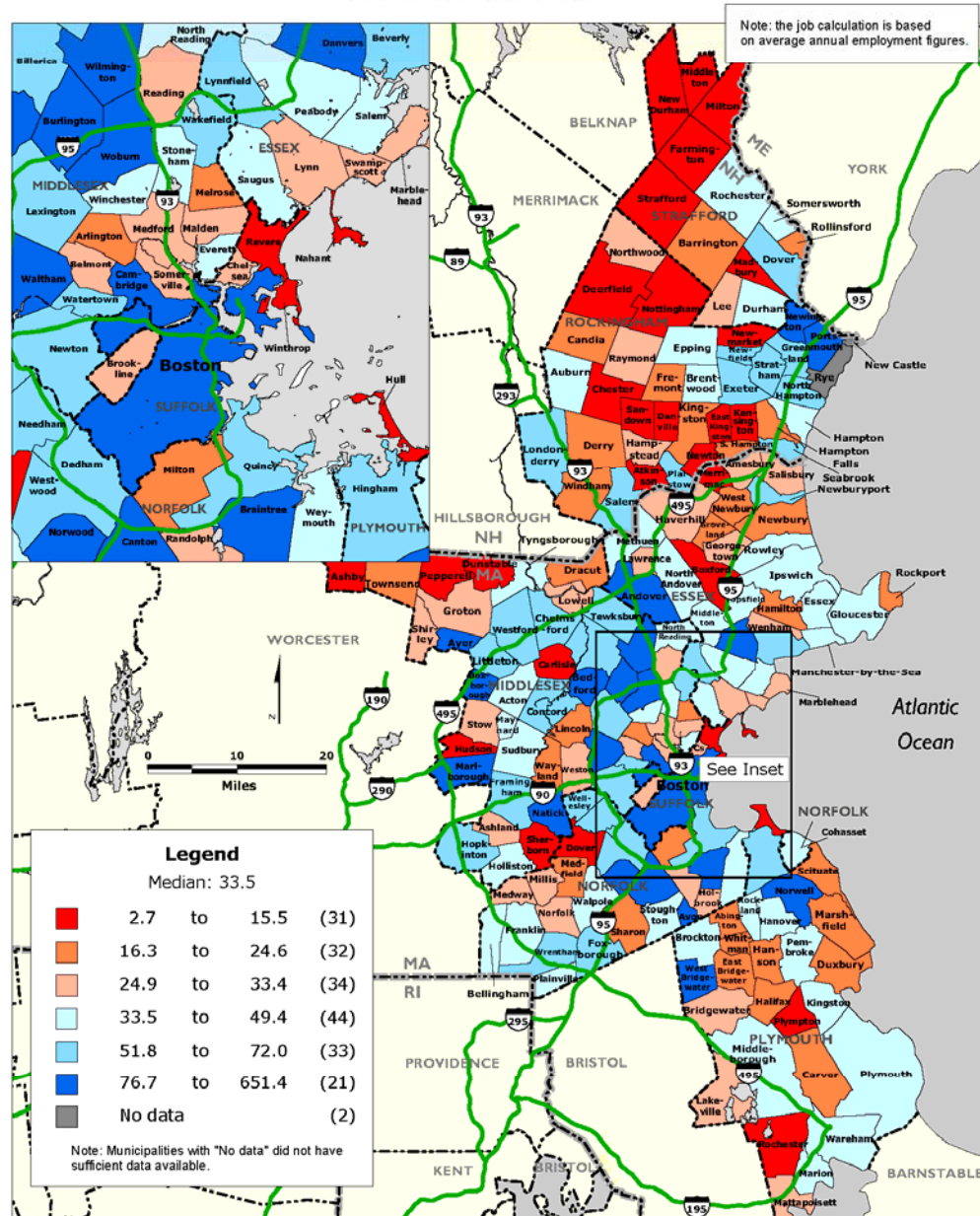

BOSTON REGION Employment Centers by Location Type

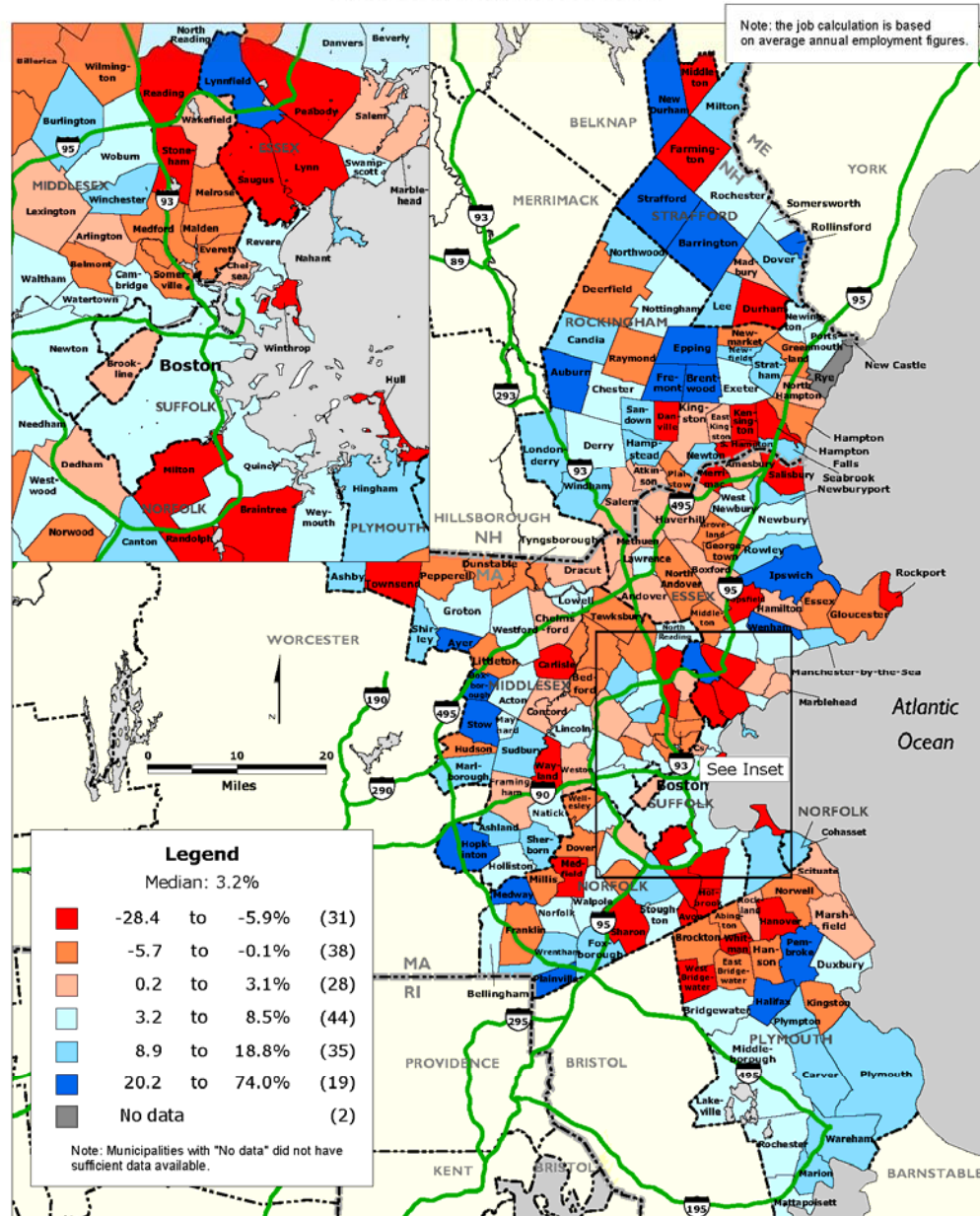


BOSTON REGION Jobs per 100 Residents by Municipality, 2008



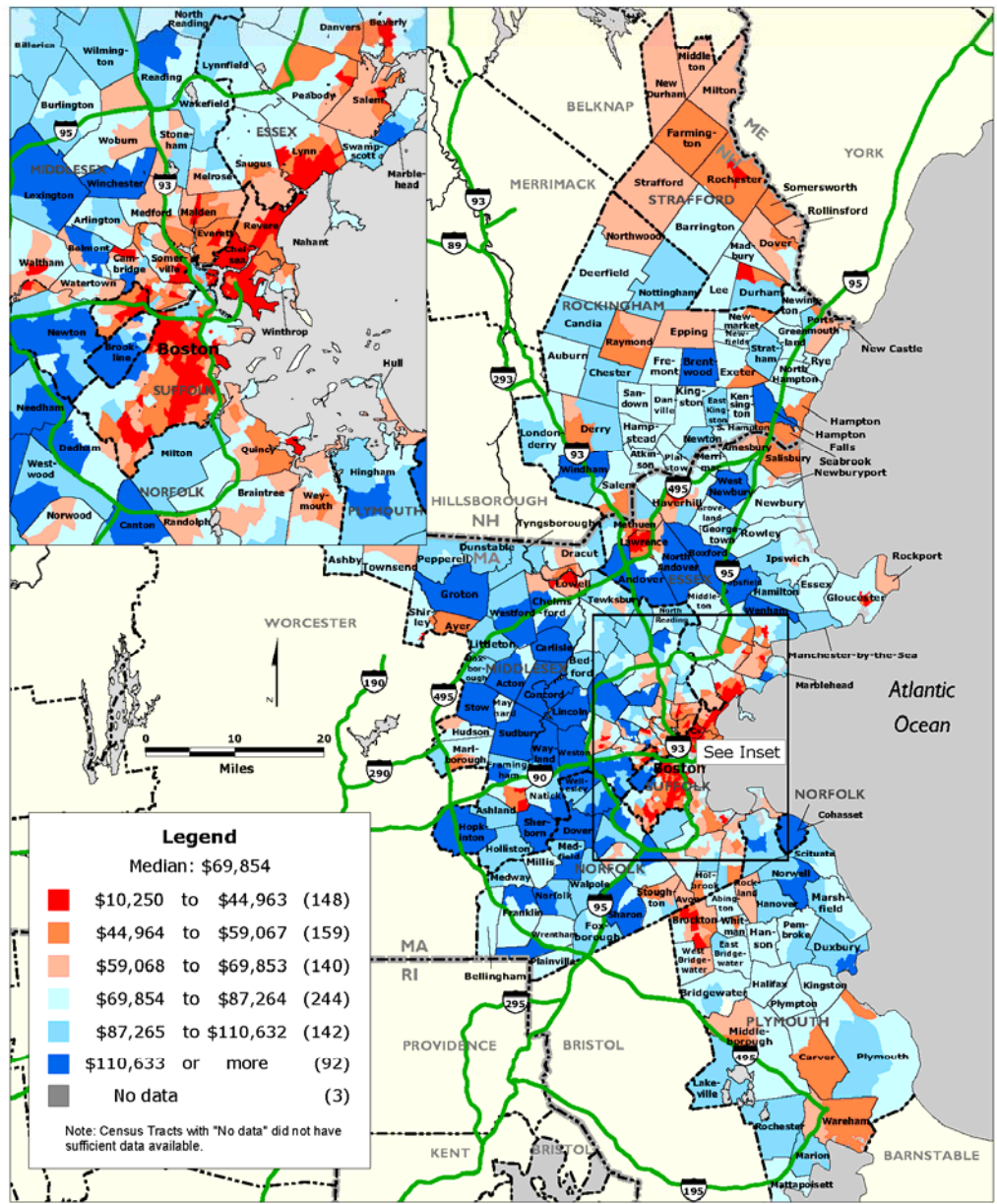

BOSTON REGION Percentage Change in Jobs by Municipality, 2003-2008

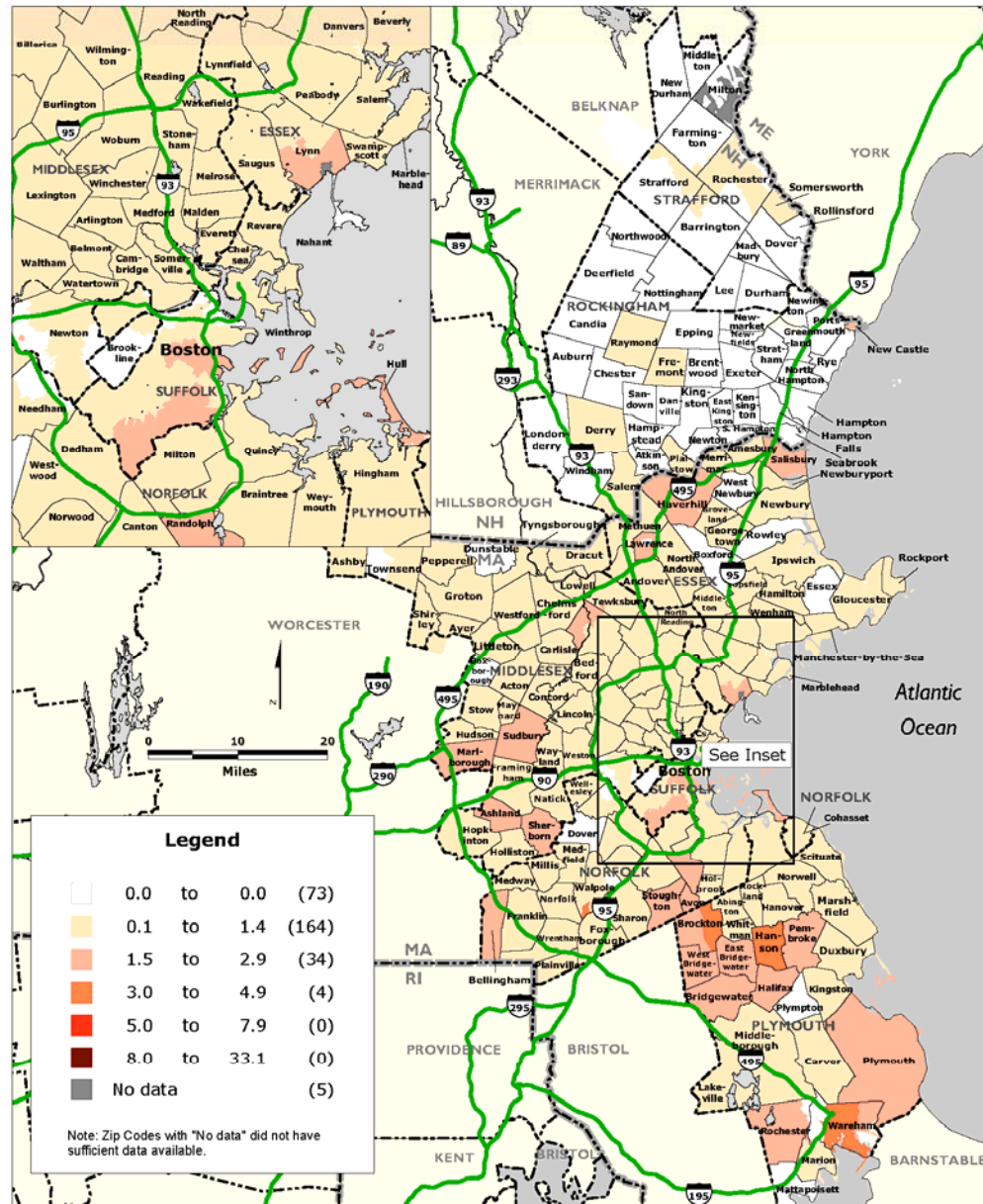

BOSTON REGION: Median Household Income by Census Tract, 2005-2009

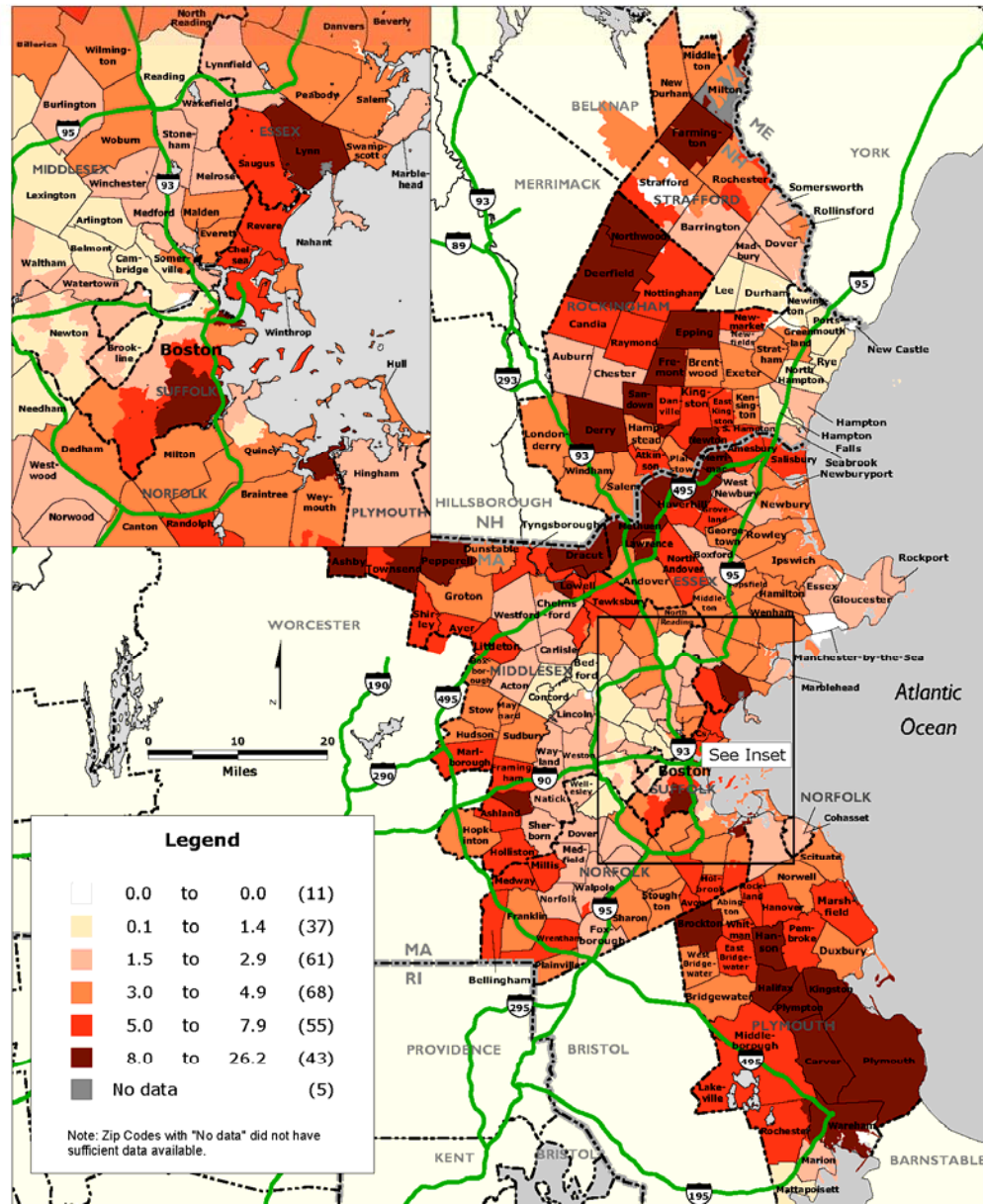


BOSTON REGION: Foreclosure Activity per 1,000 Households by Zip Code, 2nd Quarter 2005



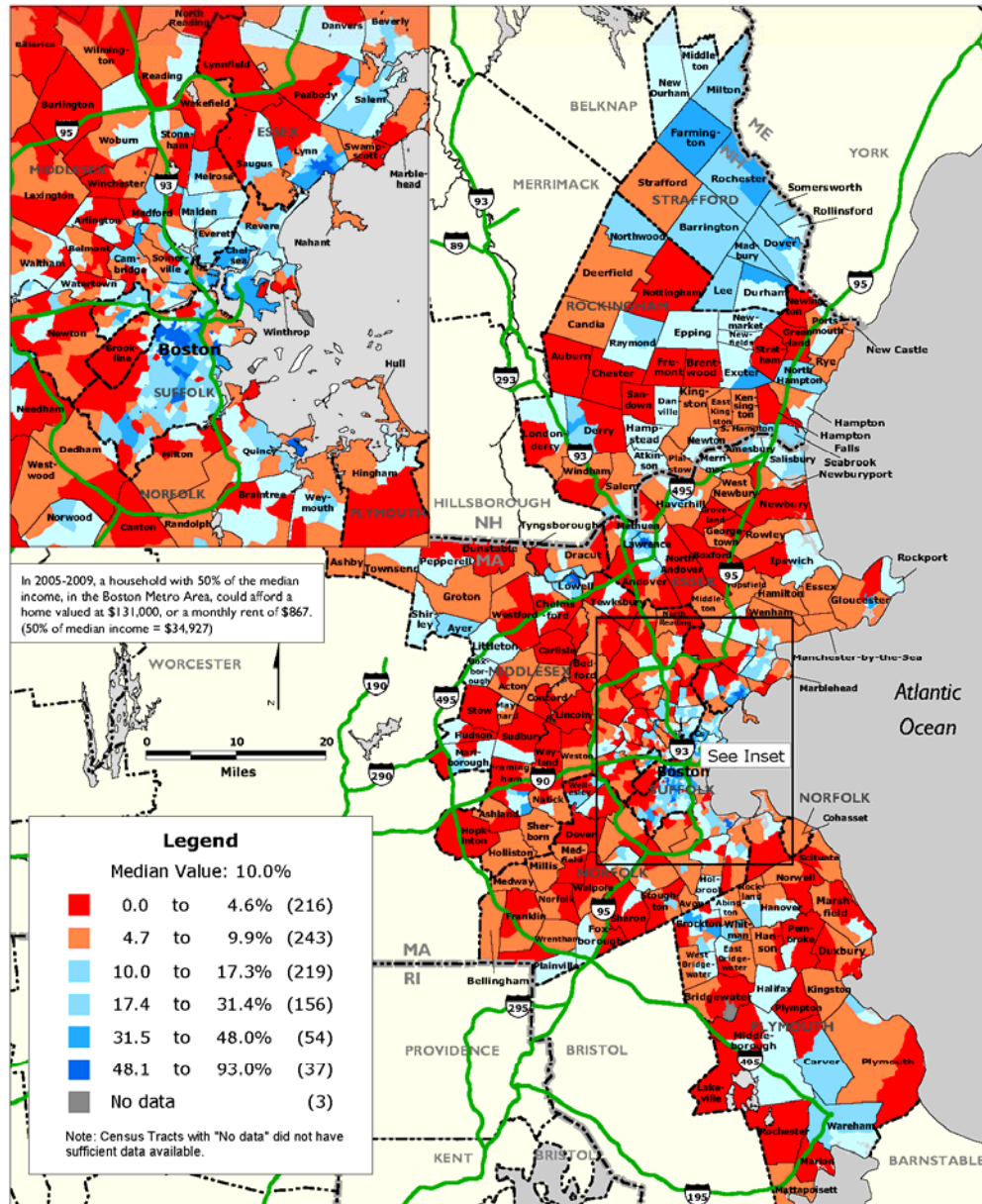

BOSTON REGION: Foreclosure Activity per 1,000 Households by Zip Code, 2nd Quarter 2010



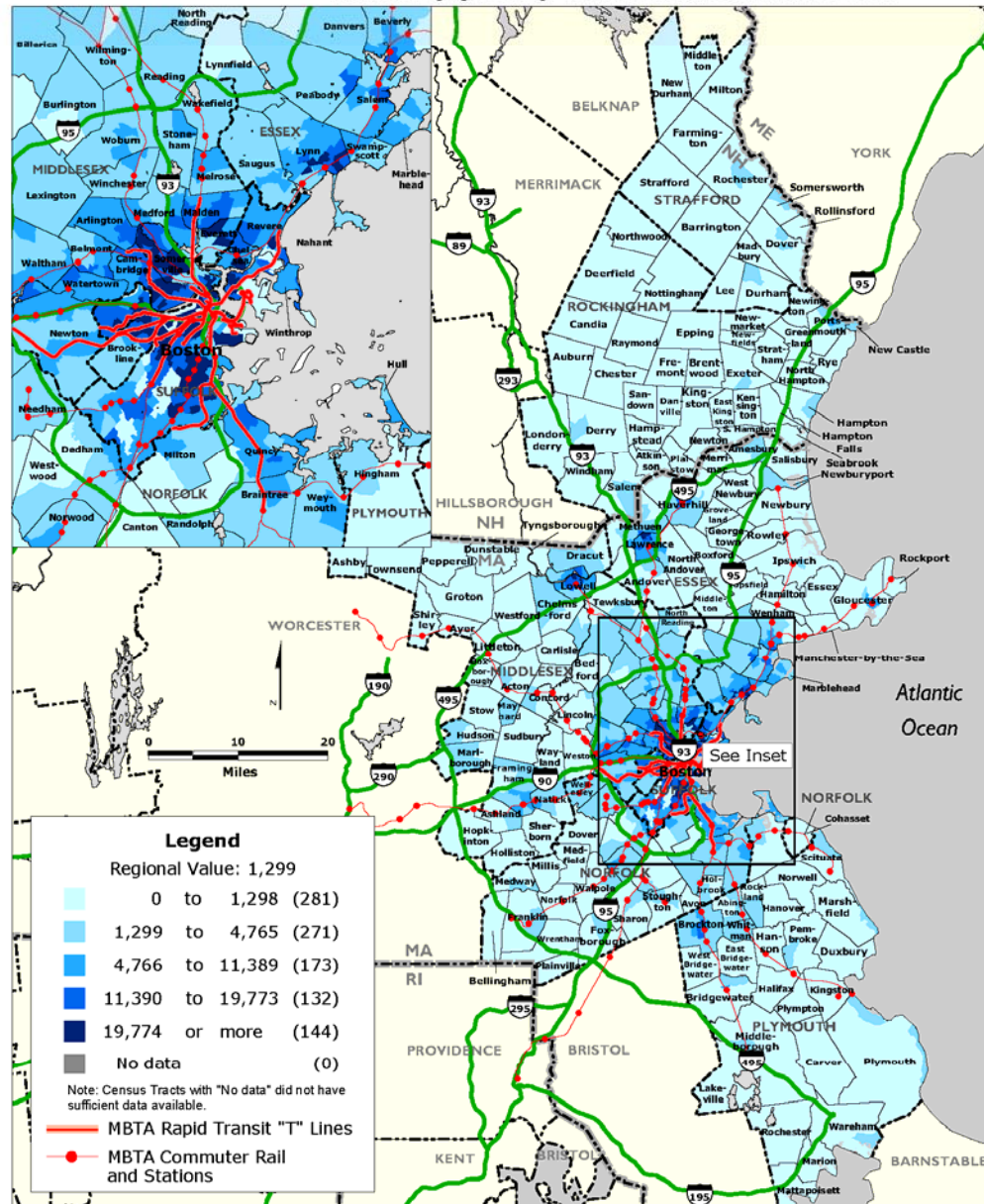
