




### MINNEAPOLIS - SAINT PAUL REGION Health and Environmental Hazards






### HENNEPIN COUNTY Number of Teen Births per 1,000 Girls (Ages 15-19) by Municipality and Minneapolis Community, 2010




### CITY OF MINNEAPOLIS Percentage of Births from Teen Mothers by City Neighborhood, 2009-2011






### CITY OF MINNEAPOLIS Percentage of Children Born with Low Birth Weights by City Neighborhood, 2009-2011






### CITY OF MINNEAPOLIS Percentage with Less than Adequate Prenatal Care by City Neighborhood, 2009-2011





### CITY OF MINNEAPOLIS Percentage of Mothers that Did Not Recieve Care in First Trimester by City Neighborhood, 2009-2011










### Residence of Felons convicted in Hennepin, Ramsey, Dakota, Anoka, Washington and Sherburne County Courts, 2005
