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


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


Cedar / Riverside Race and Ethnicity, 1990-2000




MINNEAPOLIS - SAINT PAUL REGION Integrated Neighborhoods: 1980 through 2000






MINNEAPOLIS - SAINT PAUL REGION Neighborhoods that Integrated between 1980 and 2000




West Bank / Riverside Percentage of Foreign Born Population, 2000






Cedar / Riverside Language Spoken at Home for Persons Ages 5-17 in 2000






West Bank / Riverside Workers Commuting From Area in 2000


