REPORT OF MEMBERSHIP COMMITTEE

TO THE MINNESOTA STATE BAR ASSOCIATION:

Your Committee reports as follows:

Report

Your Committee has the honor of reporting that as of March 1, 1949, there were 2,310 members of the association who had paid their dues. This exceeds the number who had paid their dues as of April 1, 1948 by fifty-three.

As of March 1, 1949, there are several members, including a few District Court Judges, who have not paid their membership dues for the fiscal year ending July 1, 1949, but your Committee has been assured that most of those members will have paid their dues prior to the State meeting in June.
